- What do you enjoy most about learning English?

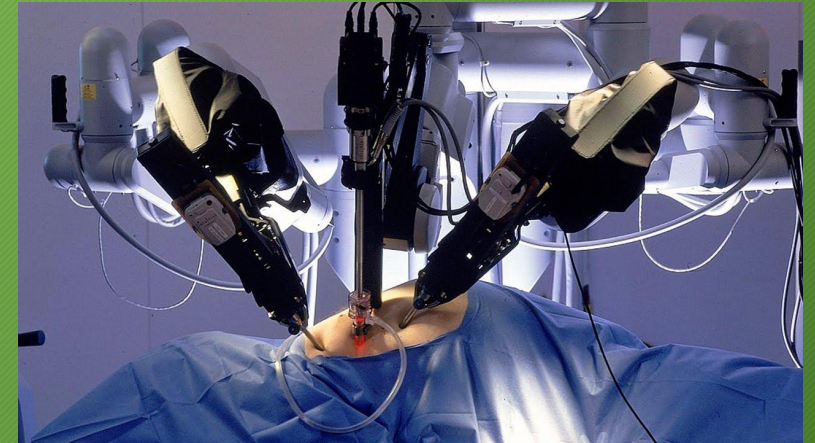
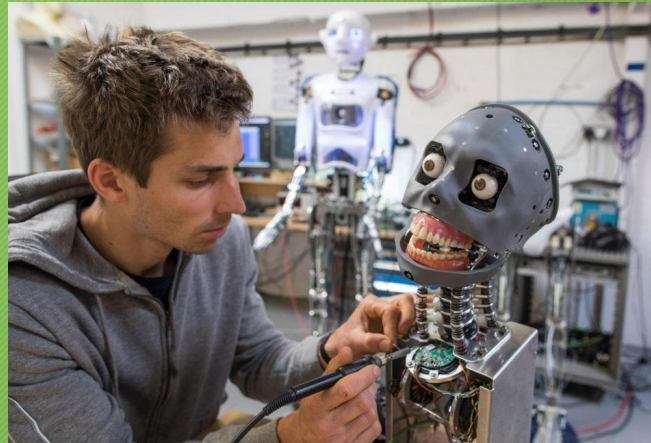

CANDIDATE A - Here are your pictures. They show people communicating with technology. Compare two pictures and say what threats can be presented by such a use of technology.

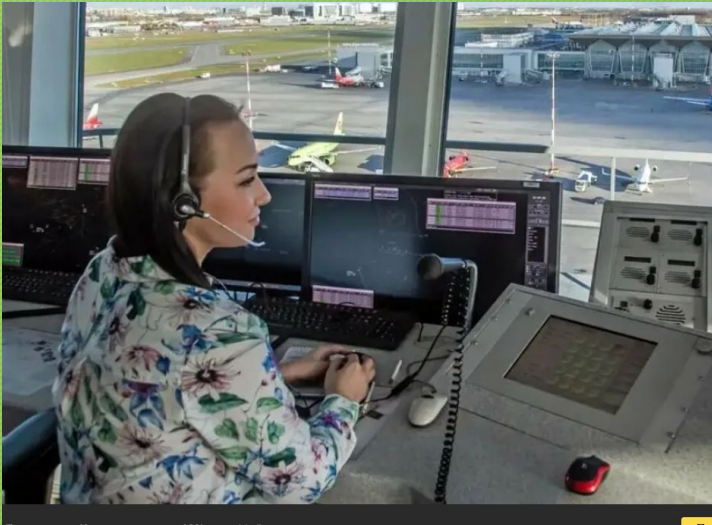


CANDIDATE B - What picture illustrates the biggest threat of a technology use?

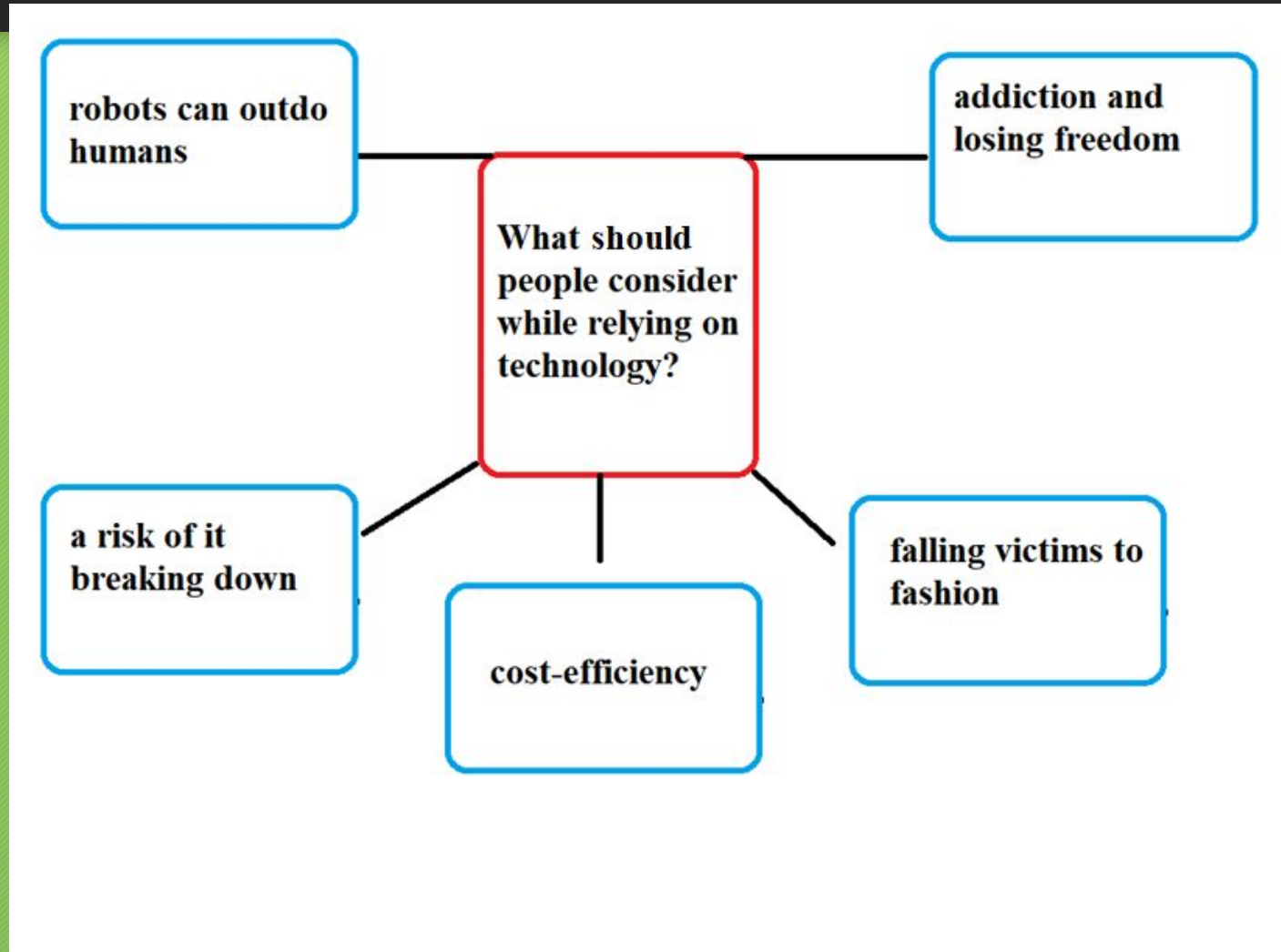
CANDIDATE C - - Here are your pictures. They show people communicating with technology. Compare two pictures and say how the people might be feeling in these situations and why.
