



- 'boxes' etc.









### The Cornell Method




- 1. Divide your paper into **two columns**
- 2. Left column: main points of the lecture, keywords, questions
- 3. Right column: **definitions**, **dates**, **facts**, **examples** etc.
- 4. Make a summary





# Mind-Mapping: show your creativity!


- 1. Put the main notion at the center of the paper






