SYDNEY

Sydney is the oldest and largest city in Australia, as well as the administrative center of New South Wales. Sydney was founded by Arthur Phillip-the head of the party of British colonists in 1788. the city was named in honor of Lord Sidney-the Minister of the interior. Since colonization, the city has grown significantly, and has become a civilized center with a population of about 3.8 million people, which today is more than 20% of the total population of Australia.

Sydney is located in the deepest part of the great Bay at the mouth of the Paramatta river. All year round, this one of the largest bays in the world is filled with a large number of vessels. It has a subtropical climate, with summer in Sydney falling in winter, but even in the winter months it is Sunny and not cold most of the time. If you move inland from Sydney, then a couple of dozen kilometers will begin the Blue mountains, a pile of steep steeps and hills. To the South and North of Sydney stretch sandy beaches and green suburbs.

The main problem for tourists in Sydney is to embrace the vast. In addition to the khabor bridge, the Opera house, zoo and Botanical garden, this huge city has a lot of interesting things.







Adelaide is the state capital and the largest city in South Australia. It has a population of about 1.2 million and is the fifth largest city in Australia. Adelaide was founded in 1836 by captain Hindmarsh. Its first population was only 200 people. The city was named after the wife of king William IV of England. Located on the banks of the river Torrens, at that time Adelaide was a swampy land, but when the city was built, the entire coast was cleared, with the exception of natural parks.





Adelaide is located at an altitude of 50 m. above sea level, and its territory is about 900 sq. km. Located near the ocean, the city attracts with its mild and warm Mediterranean climate. Fine wines and products make up a significant share of the state's economy. Grapes are grown for making wines in the Barossa, Claire and McLaren valleys. Today, the city is the financial center of the state of South Australia. The country is currently experiencing economic growth, and the economy in Adelaide is growing faster than the economy of Australia as a whole.









You should definitely visit the island Kangaroos - in a unique nature reserve, where you can admire a colony of sea lions and seals that are there in natural conditions, see wombats, echidnas and other amazing Australian animals.













Also, Adelaide is the main festival center of the country, where a continuous stream of fantastic and high-class local and international festivals are held.





PERTH

The city of Perth is the capital of the state of Western Australia. It is located in the South-Western part of the continent on the coast of the Indian ocean. Perth is one of the five most populous cities in the country. It is home to about 1 million 200 thousand people. The weather in the city corresponds to the Mediterranean climate. Perth is a rapidly developing city, one of the main economic centers of the country. The most developed are mining, oil refining, chemical and food industries. Deposits of gold, Nickel, and diamonds have been discovered and developed here.

A special feature of the city is its amazing unique nature, preserved thanks to unique weather conditions. South of Perth, there are endless flower fields and rare giant Curry trees. North of the city is Nambang national Park, where in the middle of a lifeless desert are Pinnacles-the remains of a petrified forest, representing a fantastic unearthly picture.

Canberra is the capital of Australia. The city is located at the foot of the mountains, but it is not located near the sea, which distinguishes it from other major cities in the country and gives a more relaxed rhythm of life. Canberra became the capital of Australia as a compromise in the fight for this title between Sydney and Melbourne. Today, Canberra is a surprisingly elegant city full of fragrant gardens and green parks. This city is considered a city of order, since it was originally built according to a certain clear scheme.

In Canberra, the construction of any industrial enterprises is prohibited, as well as continuous development, which is why there are many parks and gardens with vegetation from different countries: Japanese Sakura, Siberian cedar, etc.
