We use the present continuous to talk about something that is happening now. We make the present continuous with am, is, are + a verb with -ing.

Long forms

Short forms

I am talking. You/We/They are talking. He/She/It is talking.

I'm talking. You/We/They're talking. He/She/It's talking.

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ing

When the verb ends in -e, we drop the -e and add -ing. dance + ing → dancing take + ing → taking

When a verb of one syllable ends with a vowel and a consonant, we sometimes double the consonant and add -ing.

swim + ing \rightarrow swimming run+ ing \rightarrow running
