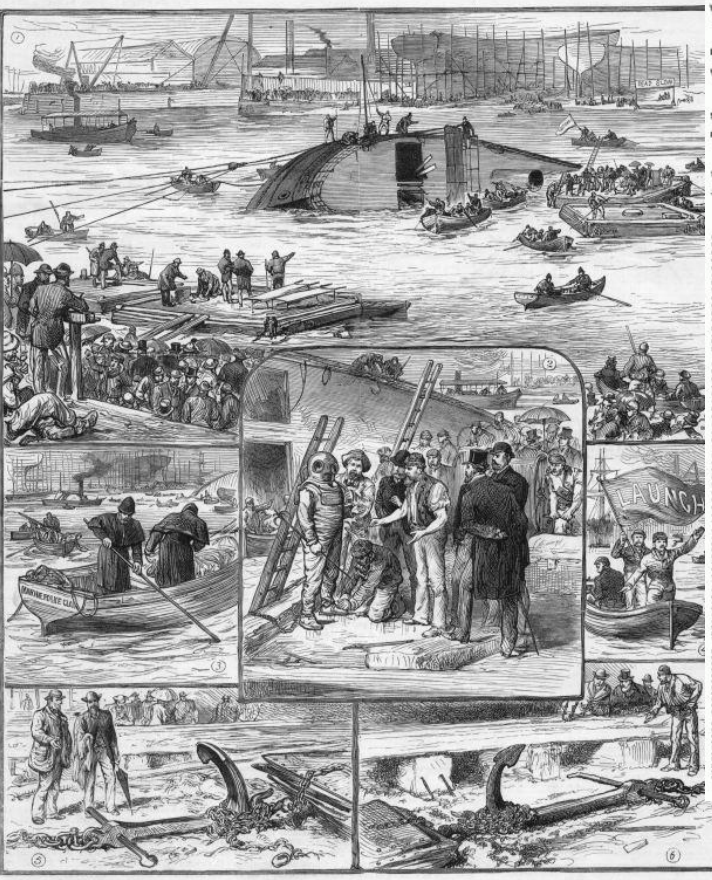

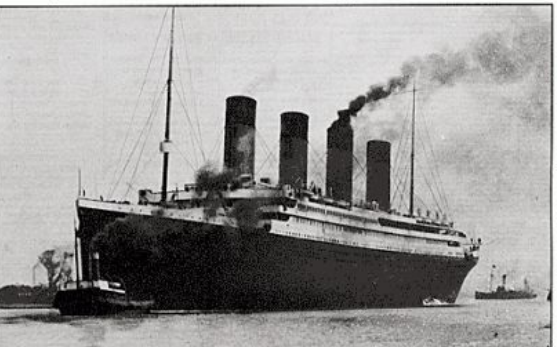

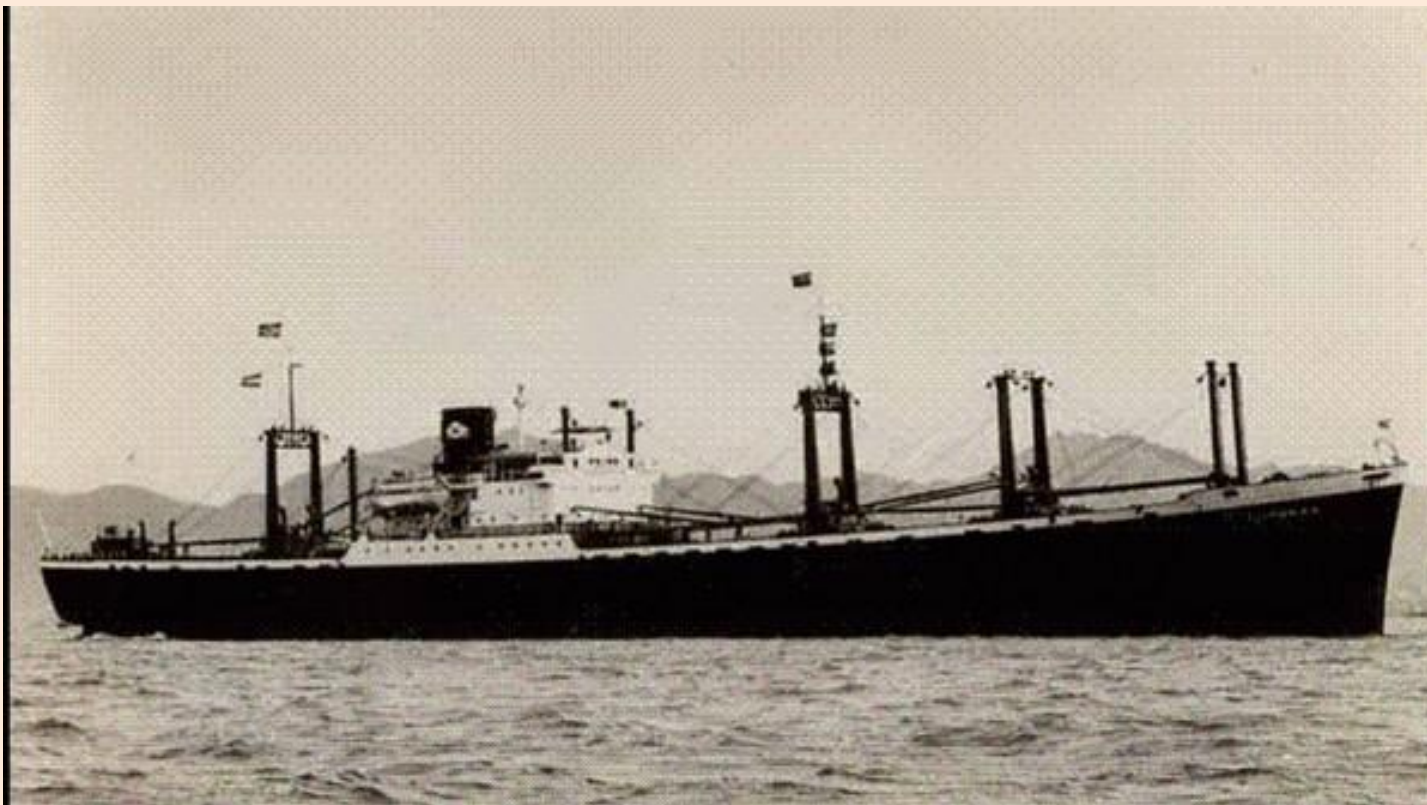

В феврале 1948 года несколько кораблей поспешили на помощь голландскому грузовому судну «**Ourang Medan**», терпевшему бедствие у берегов Индонезии. *«Все офицеры и капитан лежат замертво в рубке и на мостике. Возможно, мертва вся команда. Я умираю»*, — это последнее сообщение, которое было передано с «Ourang Medan» окрестным судам. Спасательная партия не нашла ни одного живого человека. У мертвого экипажа был ожесточенный и напуганный вид. Даже у собаки на морде был страшный оскал.



В январе 2003 года недалеко от Австралии было замечено тайваньское судно «High Aim 6». На борту никого не было. Почему судно брошено, не ясно: был запас топлива и продовольствия.

В марте 2006 года у берегов Австралии спасательная команда поднялась на борт танкера «Jian Seng». Следов экипажа не было...
