dentist twice a year.



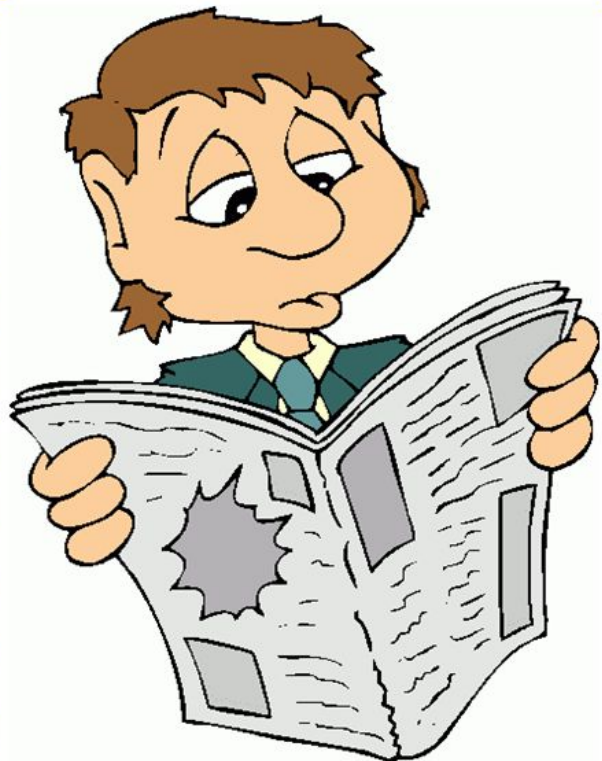

in the summer.



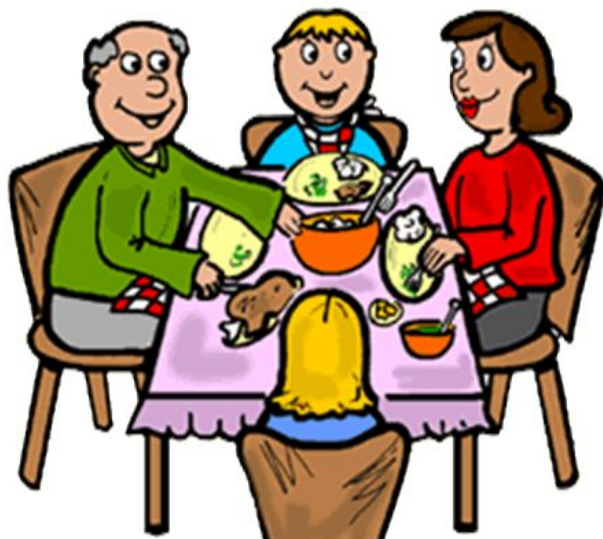
