The Robinsons

The Robinsons are a British family. They live in Manchester. This is their usual weekday. They get up at 6.30. Tom Robinson goes to the bathroom. He turns on the <u>tap</u>, has a shower, cleans his teeth and puts on his favourite clothes — a dark blue <u>jumper</u> and grey <u>trousers</u>. While Tom is dressing his wife Mary gets their breakfast ready. She prepares eggs on the <u>cooker</u>. Tom likes a big breakfast, Mary doesn't eat much in the morning. She usually has a cup of coffee and some <u>biscuits</u>, sometimes she takes a sweet.

When Tom leaves home, he drives his <u>lorry</u> to the <u>petrol station</u>. He has a busy day in front of him. For lunch he usually has chips.

In the morning Mary cleans the flat, takes the <u>rubbish</u> out and puts it in the <u>dustbin</u> standing on the street <u>pavement</u>. Then she goes to the chemist's where she works.

Tom and Mary often drive to the <u>cinema</u>. They leave their old Ford in the <u>car park</u> and enjoy watching their favourite films.
