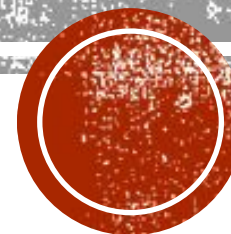


SOCIAL ENGLISH IN THE NET
