# Zero Conditional: facts and general truths

- If clause - Present Simple
- Main clause - Present Simple



# First Conditional: Likely, possible, real in the future

- If clause - Present Simple
- Main clause - Future Simple



# Second Conditional: Imaginary, Unreal or Unlikely Situations/To give advice

- If clause- Past Simple
- Main clause – Would + Verb (base form)



# Third Conditional: Unreal, impossible situations in the past

- If clause - Past Perfect
- Main clause - Would + Have + V3



# Third Conditional: Changing the Past

- If clause - Past Perfect
- Main clause - Would + Present Perfect



# Other modals Can be used in

## First, Second + Third conditionals

If she studies, she **might** get good grades.

If she studies, she **could** get good grades.

If she won the lottery, she **might** buy me a car.

If she won the lottery, she **could** buy me a car.

"If I hurry, I'll see my brother before he leaves."



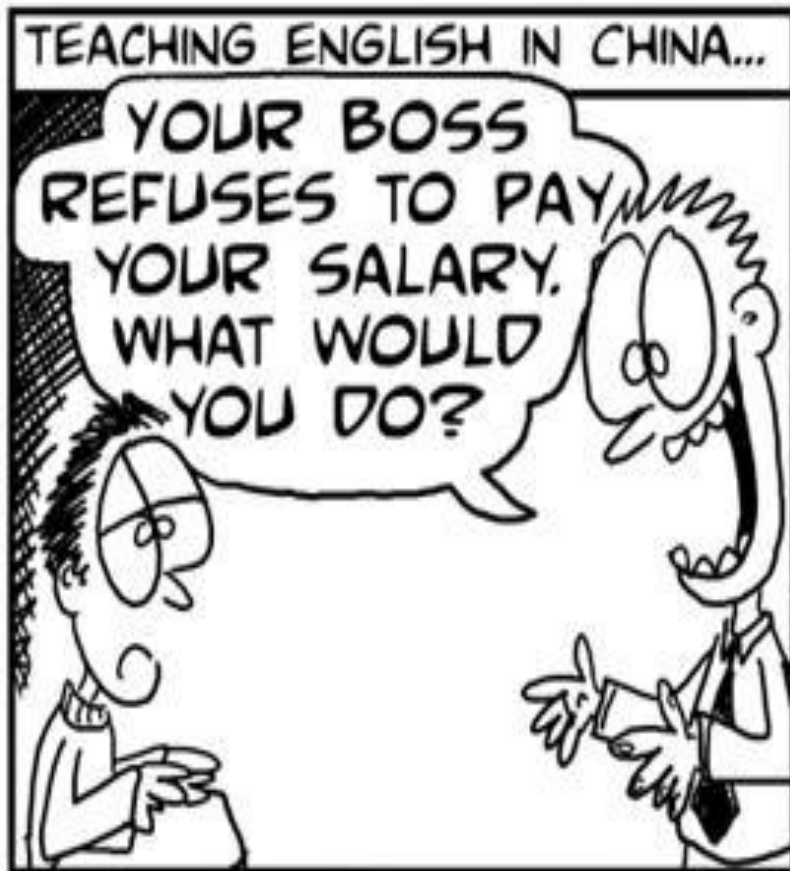
"If I see him, I can borrow £10 off him."

If I had a better motorbike, I would be on time.

If I catch a goldfish, I will be incredibly rich!

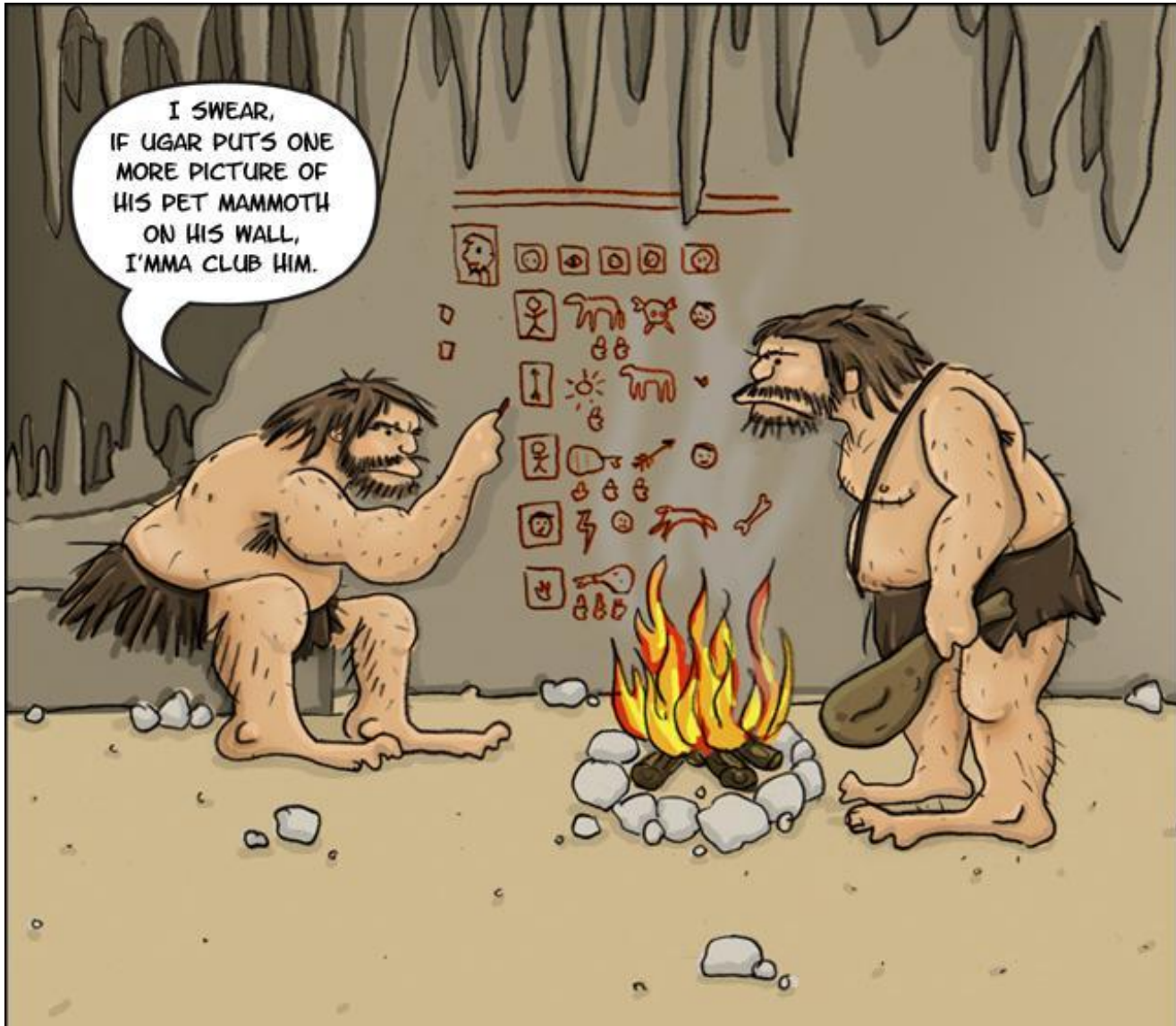
