



Conditionals

Zero Conditional: facts and general truths

- If clause Present Simple
- Main clause Present Simple







First Conditional: Likely, possible, real in the future

- If clause Present Simple
- Main clause <u>Future Simple</u>







Second Conditional: Imaginary, Unreal or Unlikely Situations/To give advice

- If clause- Past Simple
- Main clause Would + Verb (base form)



Third Conditional: Unreal, impossible situations in the past

- If clause Past Perfect
- Main clause Would + Have + V3



Third Conditional: Changing the Past

- If clause Past Perfect
- Main clause Would + Present Perfect








Other modals Can be used in

If she <u>studies</u>, she than get good grades. If she <u>studies</u>, she than get good grades. If she <u>won</u> the lottery, she <u>might</u> buy me a car.

If she <u>won</u> the lottery, she <u>could</u> buy me a car.




"If I hurry, I'll see my " brother before he leaves."

If I had slept last night, I **would have** been more alert during class.




Had I slept last night, I **would have** been more alert during class. If you guys come over tonight, I'll order us a pizza!


