

I wanted to tell you about the writer Dmitry Glukhovsky





Prologue

The events were postponed eight days before the battle at the Ostankino TV tower, which began with the awakening of Artyom at the VDNKh metro station. The station became his home after his stepfather Alexander Sukhoi brought him here. He introduced Artyom to a man named Hunter, who was instrumental in countering the attacks of the mutants. According to Sukhoi, the attacks are not so dangerous compared to the threat of the appearance of "black" - mysterious humanoid creatures that penetrate through the exit of the Botanical Garden station. "Black" can negatively affect the psyche of people at a distance and use their psychic energy, converting it into physical energy of great strength. The hunter is trying to find out more about these creatures and how to destroy them. Before leaving the station, Hunter gives Artyom a stalker token, instructing him to go to Polis, the most powerful group
