

Пять видов вопросов в английском языке

Общий	Do you have a cat?
Специальный	What is your cat doing now?
К подлежащему	What makes your cat happy?
Альтернативный	Are you a cat person or a dog person?
Tag Question	You are a cat person, aren't you?

Виды вопросов в английском языке

1) Общий: узнать общую информацию (ответ yes/no).

2) Специальный: узнать конкретизированную информацию о чем-то (what/where/when...).

3) Вопрос к подлежащему: узнать, кто выполнял какие либо действия (who) .

4) Альтернативный: необходимо выбрать один из двух вариантов (or).

5) Разделительный: с целью подтвердить какие-либо факты (aren't you?/don't you - не так ли?).

Past Simple	<p>Who <u>took</u> a picture of a lizard in the zoo last week?</p>	<p>Вспом. гл. не нужен, но смысловой глагол должен стоять в прошедшем времени.</p>
Future Simple	<p>Who will <u>arrange</u> a picnic for her friends tomorrow?</p>	
Can May Must	<p>Who can <u>give</u> me some advice?</p> <p>Who may <u>close</u> the window?</p> <p>Who must <u>do</u> this exercise?</p>

Can May Must	<p>Can <u>you</u> <u>drive</u> a car or a motor bike?</p> <p>May <u>I</u> <u>close</u> the window or the door?</p> <p>Must <u>I</u> <u>read</u> or <u>learn</u> the poem?</p>
