was to be were

Ving

Use the **Past Continuous** to describe an action happening at a **certain time in the past**.

What **were** you **doing** at 5 o'clock yesterday?



We were looking at photos.



was/were + Ving

+ ing	- ie → y + ing	- e → ing	double consonant + ing
.....listening.....dying.....diving.....travelling.....

spelling -ing

What **were** you doing?
I **was** looking at photos.

He **wasn't** making a smoothie.
He **was** making a mess.

Were they going to the train station?
No, they **weren't**. They **were** going to the theatre.

be + Ving.

be + not + Ving.

? Was/Were _____ Ving ?

Yes, I was. / No, I wasn't.
Yes, they were. / No, they weren't.

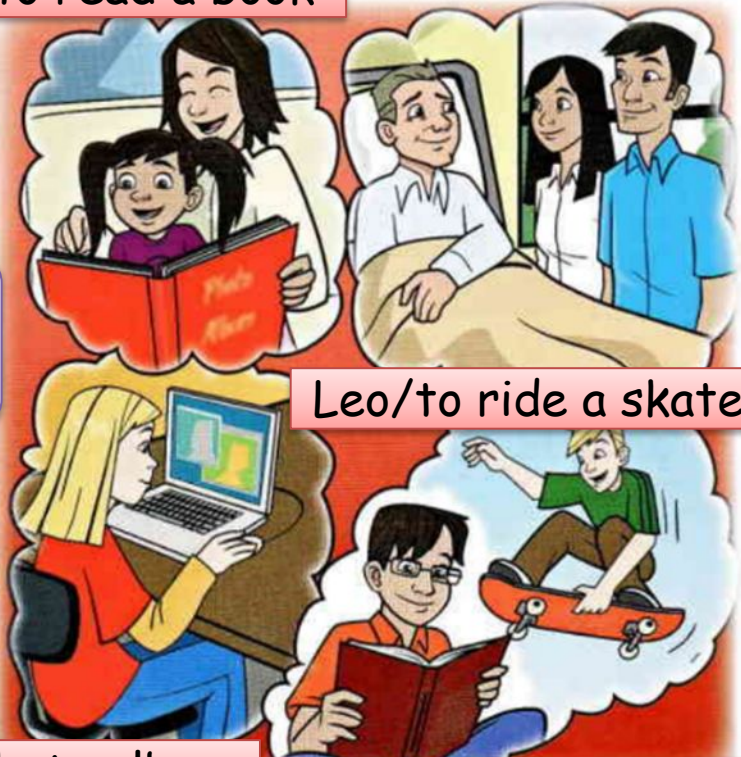
