

What is Schizophrenia

→ Schizophrenia is a mental disorder.

→ Around 20 million people in the world have schizophrenia.

→ The disease was first identified by Dr. Emile Kraepelin



Types of schizophrenia



- → Paranoid schizophrenia.
- → Catatonic schizophrenia.
- → Undifferentiated schizophrenia.
- → Schizoaffective disorder.

Symptoms

- → confused speech
- → lack of facial expression
- → lack of emotional expression
- → lack of motivation
- → difficulty concentrating
- → psychosis
- → hallucinations



What Causes Schizophrenia?

- → Genetics (heredity)
- → Brain abnormality
- → Environment





How Is Schizophrenia Diagnosed?

- the doctor will perform a complete medical history and a physical exam.
- the doctor use various tests, and possibly blood tests or brain imaging studies.
- psychiatrists and psychologists use specially designed interviews and assessment tools to evaluate a person for a psychotic disorder.

Treatment

- antipsychotic drugs.
- counseling.coordinated special care.
- medications for schizophrenia
