

Indefinite pronouns

Pronouns ending in -one or -body are used to refer to people.

Example

Everyone is ready to go.

Pronouns ending in -thing are used to refer to things.

Example

Everything had gone silent.

Pronouns ending in -where are used to refer to places that you do not know.

Example

I've looked everywhere for it.



Indefinite Pronouns II



- The indefinite pronouns anyone, anybody, everyone, everybody, someone, somebody, no one, nobody, each, much, and one are always singular.
- Think of anybody and everybody as referring to each "single body" = one body = singular
- Logically *many*, *few*, *both*, *several*, etc. are always plural—always more than one.
