*set*

- **in** *приходить*
- **off** *отправиться*
- **aside** *накопить*
- **back** *задержать*

1. The spring set ...: the weather was warm and pleasant.
2. It's late, we should set ... as soon as we can.
3. If you want to go abroad you'd better set ... enough money for it.
4. The storm set the travellers ... for a day.
5. The frosty weather set ... and we put our warm clothes on.

- Foreign ... strange ... curious ...

□ without	delay	
□ in		<i>безотлагателно</i>
	at	<i>заранее</i>
