about it.

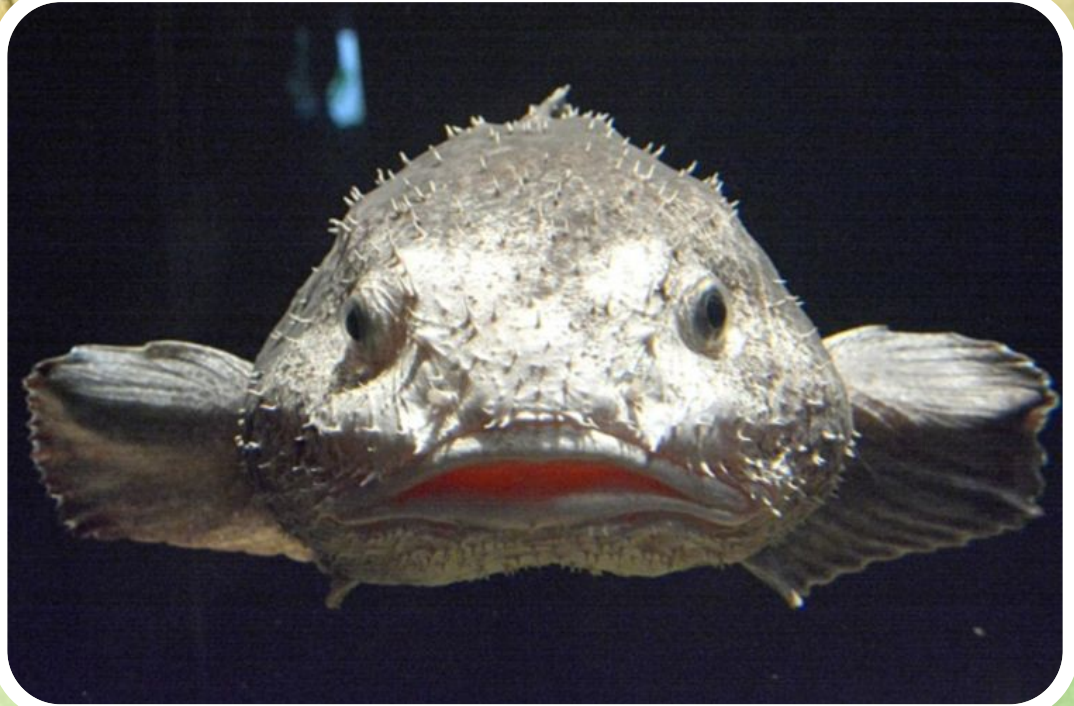




This is a **BLOBFISH** from Australia.



In the water it looks like this.





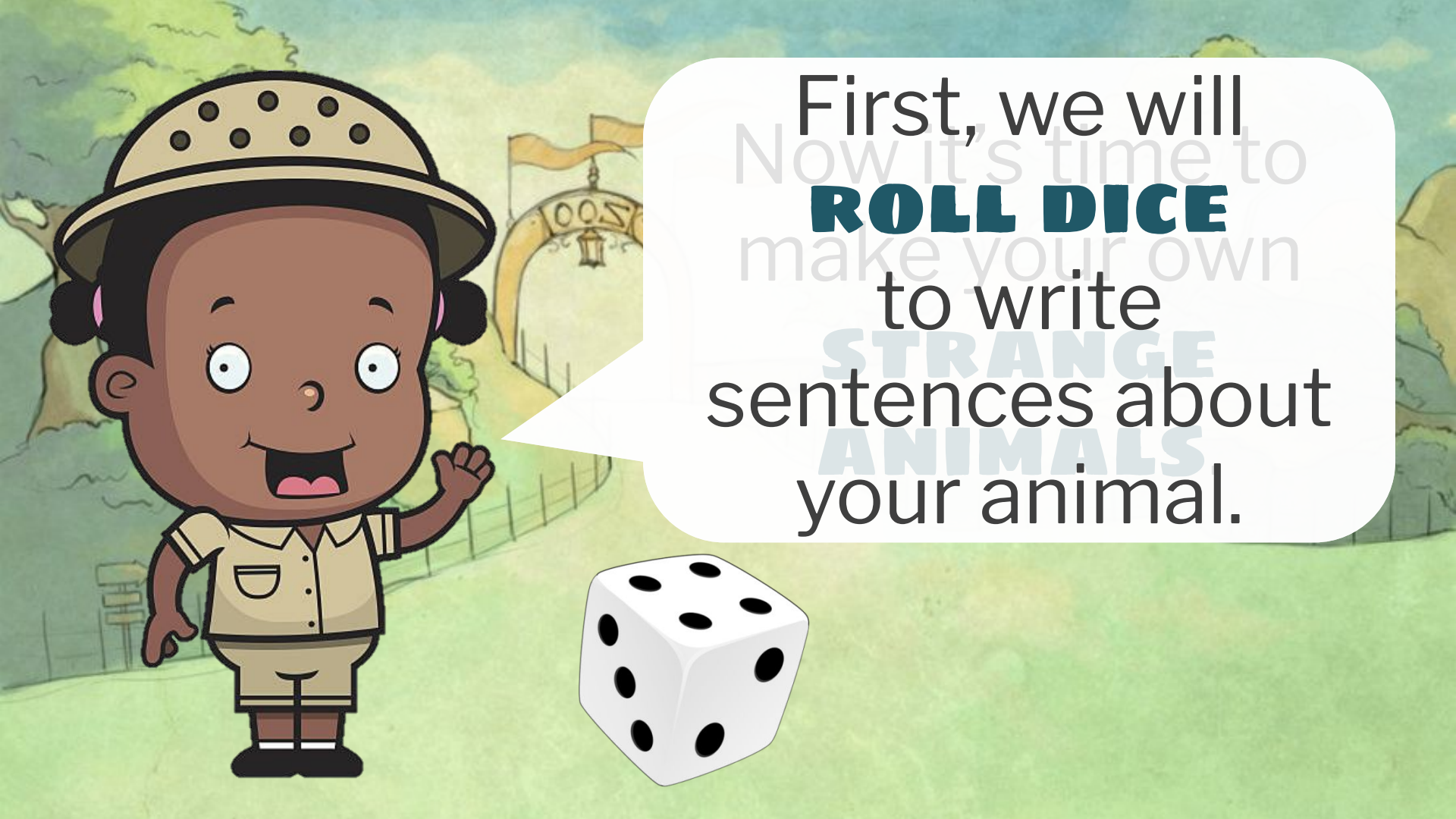
