Fish swim in the sea.

Birds

fly.

Money doesn't buy happiness.

timetables

The match finishes at 7:45.

The plane leaves at 6:15.

School starts at 8 o'clock.

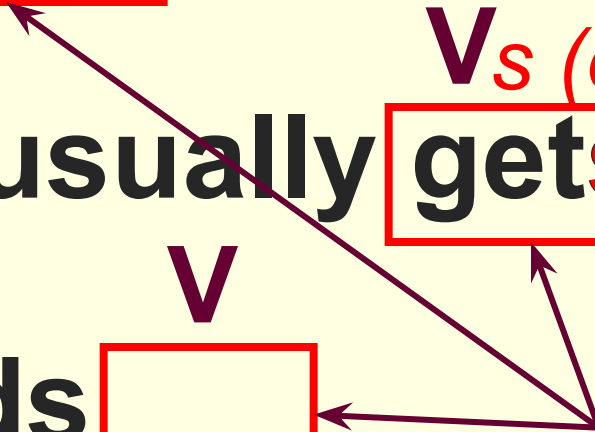

does not V
(It) The plane **doesn't** leave at 5.

does not V
(It) A hen **doesn't** fly.
