Later ships were used for overseas travels which gave the world a lot of important discoveries

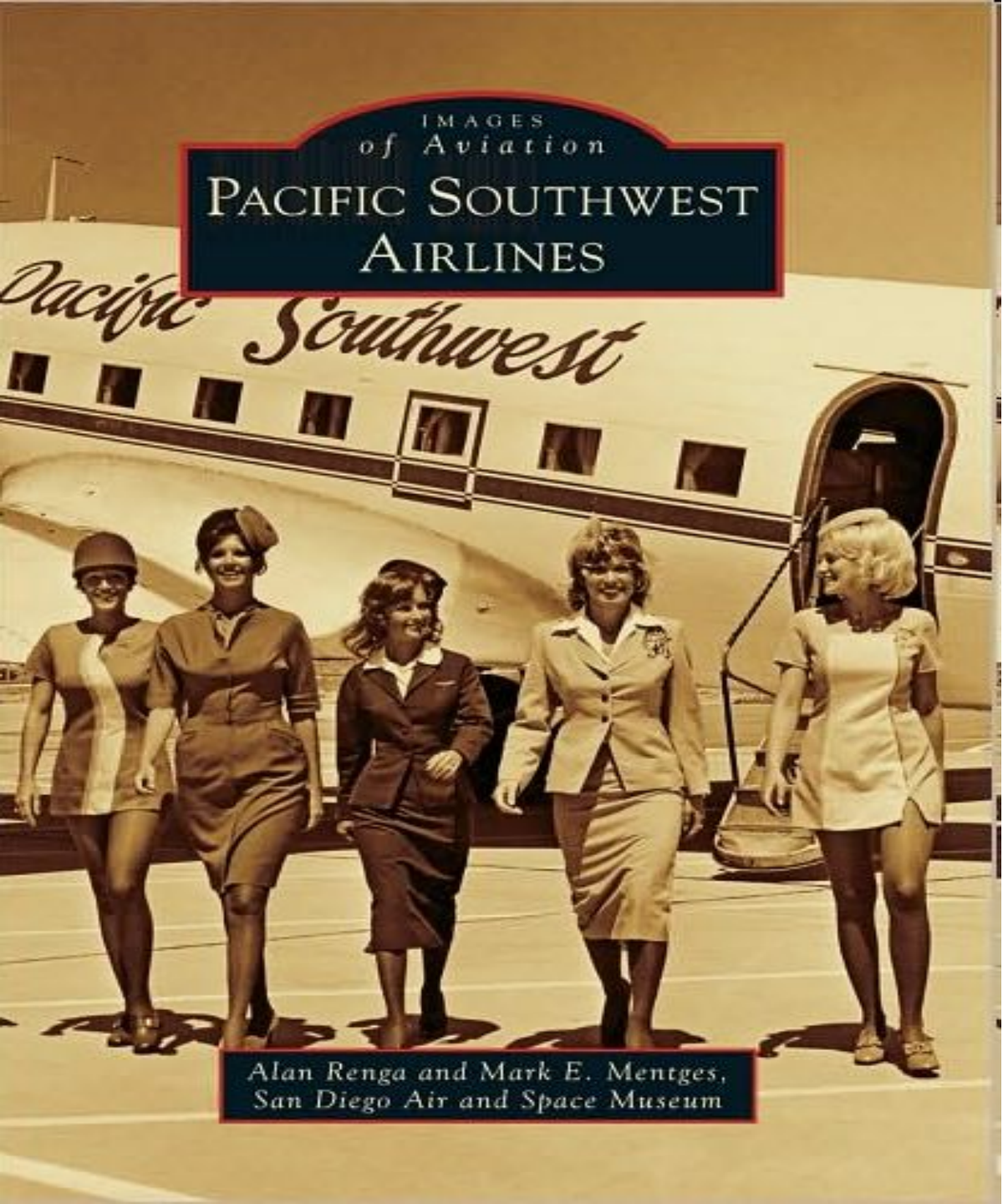


The first trains started traveling in the 19th century – in the USA they helped thousands of people to travel to far places in the west – but often were attacked by gangs of outlaws
