

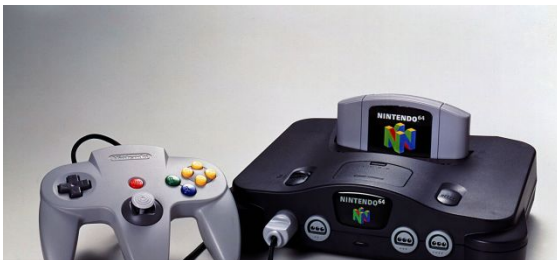

We form imperatives with the infinitive of the verb without *to*. We form the negative with *don't*.

*Please reply to my email. Don't click on that link.*

We put *always* and *never* before the verb in affirmative imperatives.

*Never click on links in spam email.*
