 - It's the main language of business, sports, science.

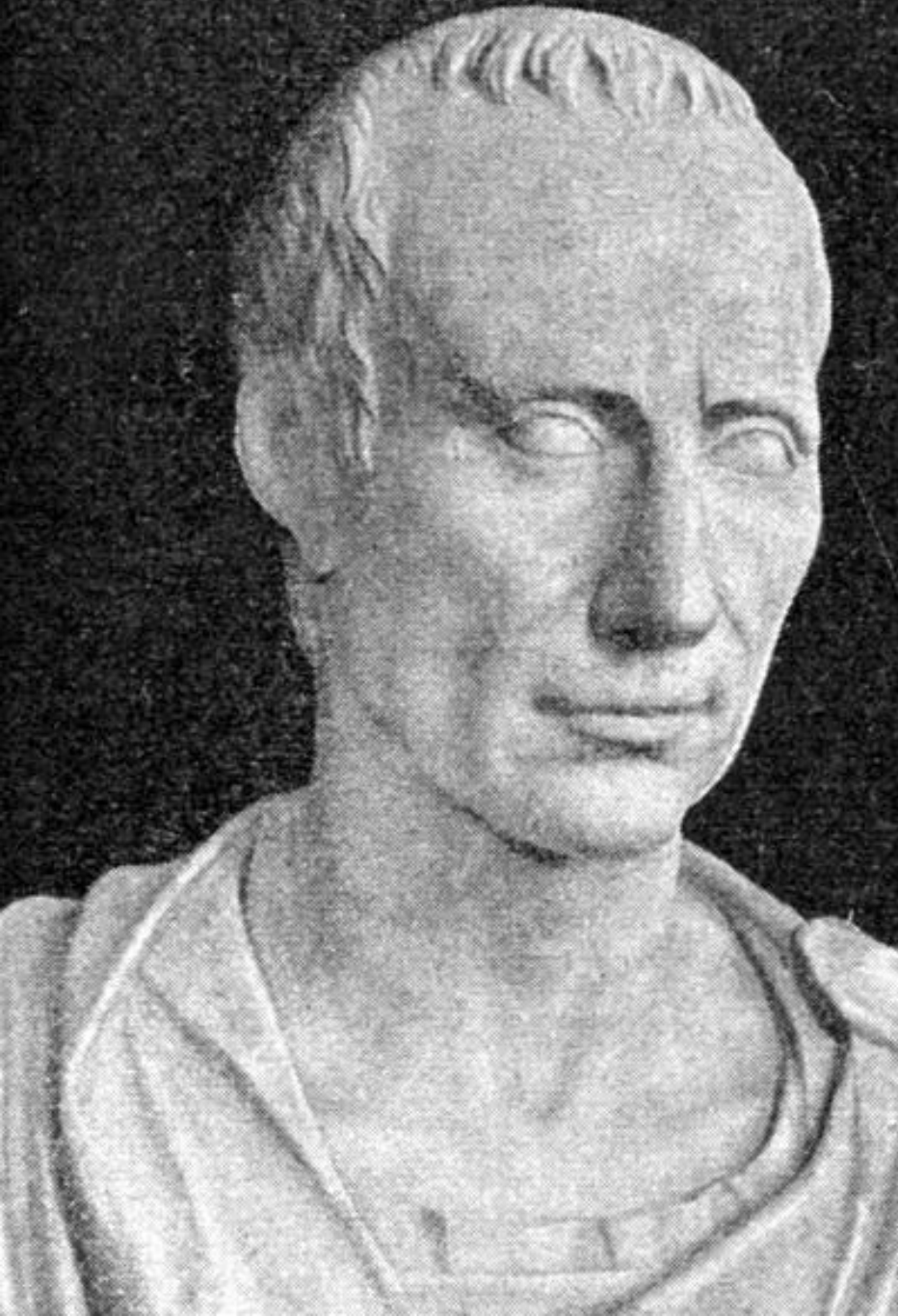
Why do people study English?

To understand, why English has become so popular and rich, we should remember the history of this country.

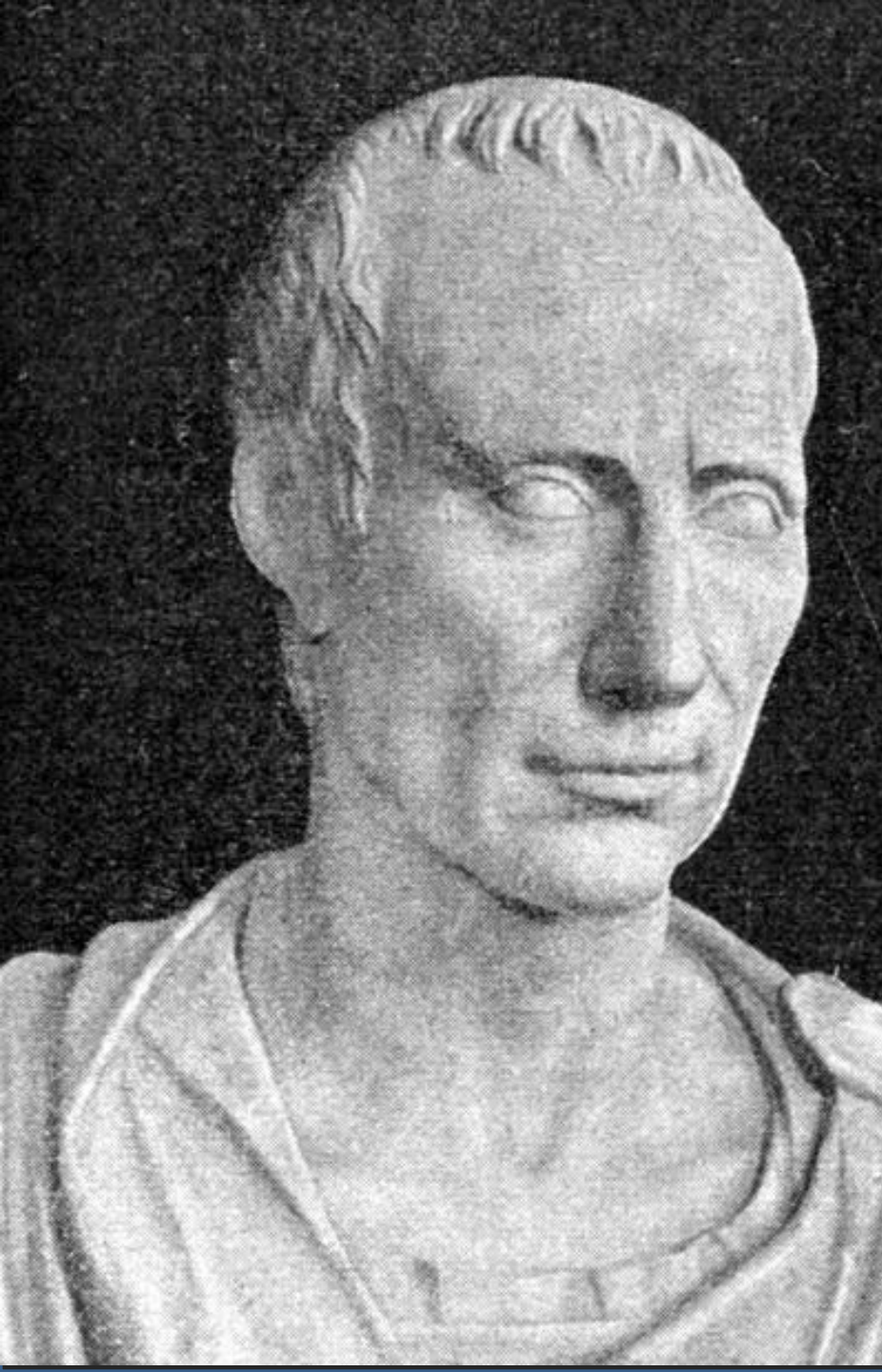

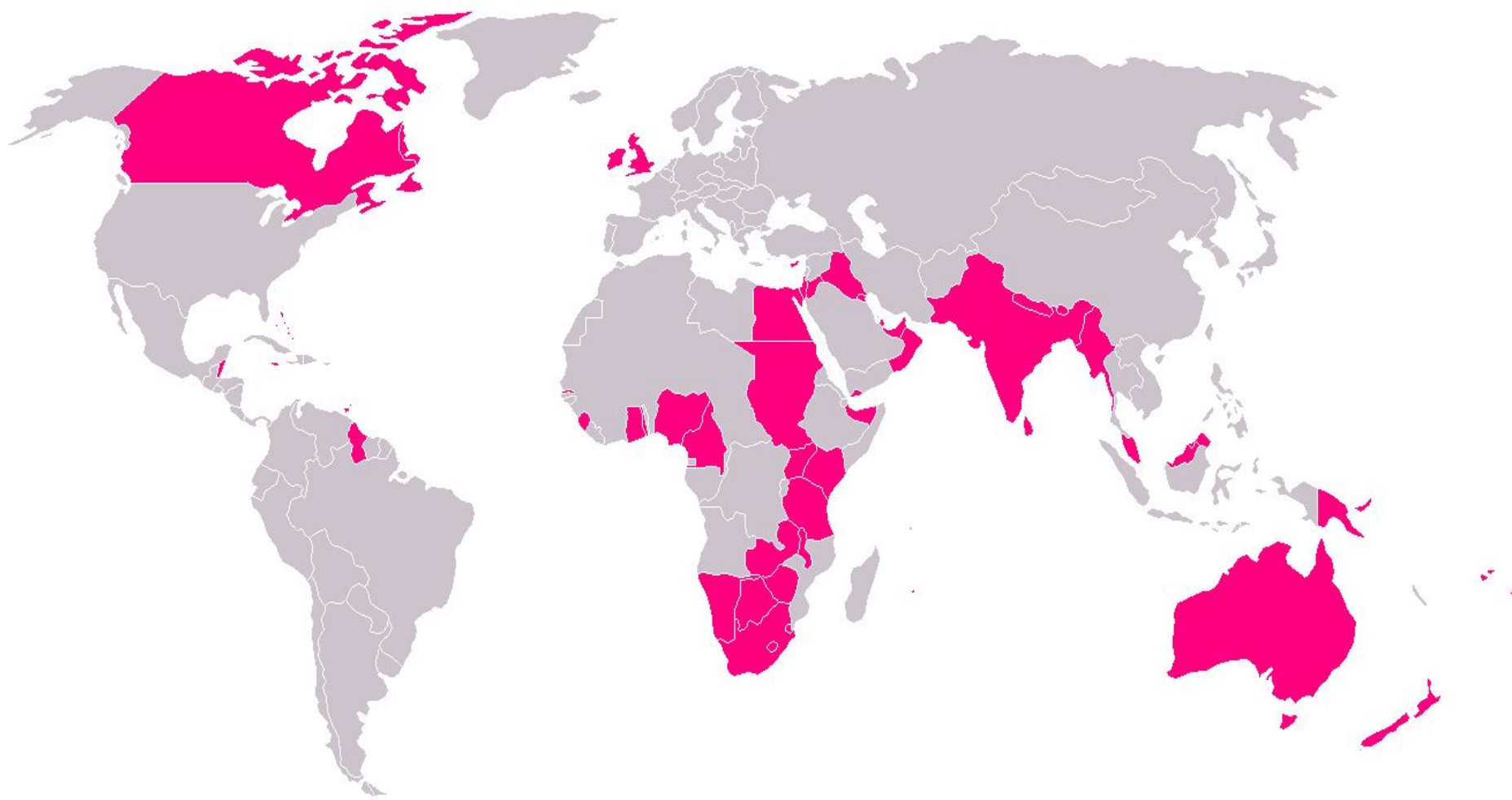


Elizabeth I comes to the throne in the 16 century.
