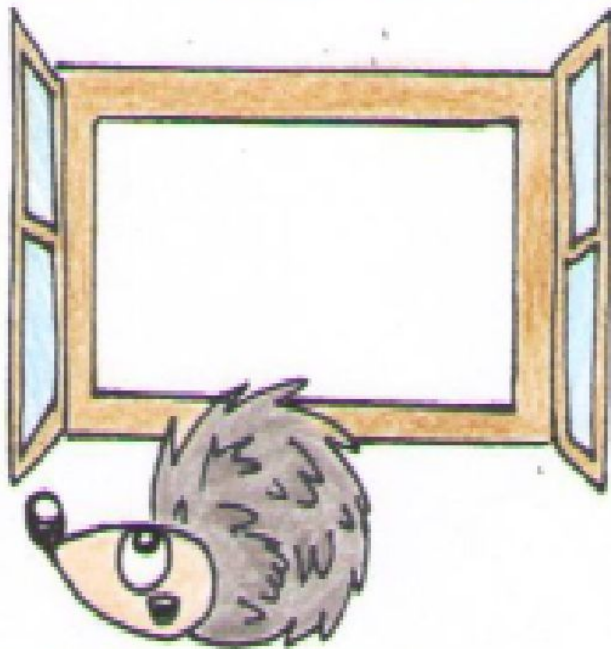

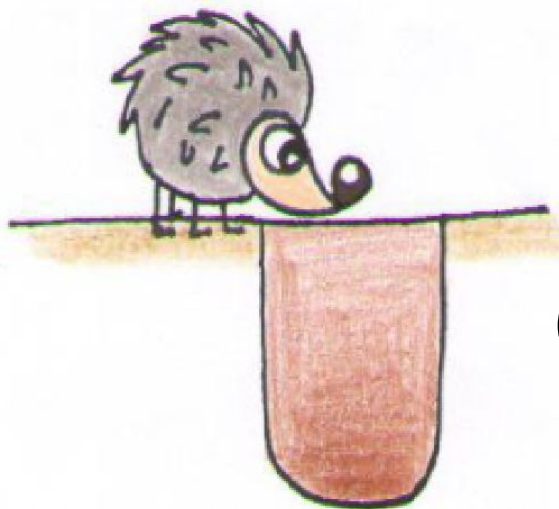

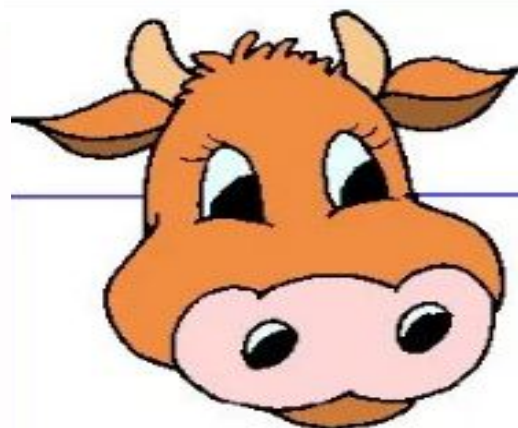

Nouns ending in consonant + **y** → **ies**.

country → countries

baby → babies

But

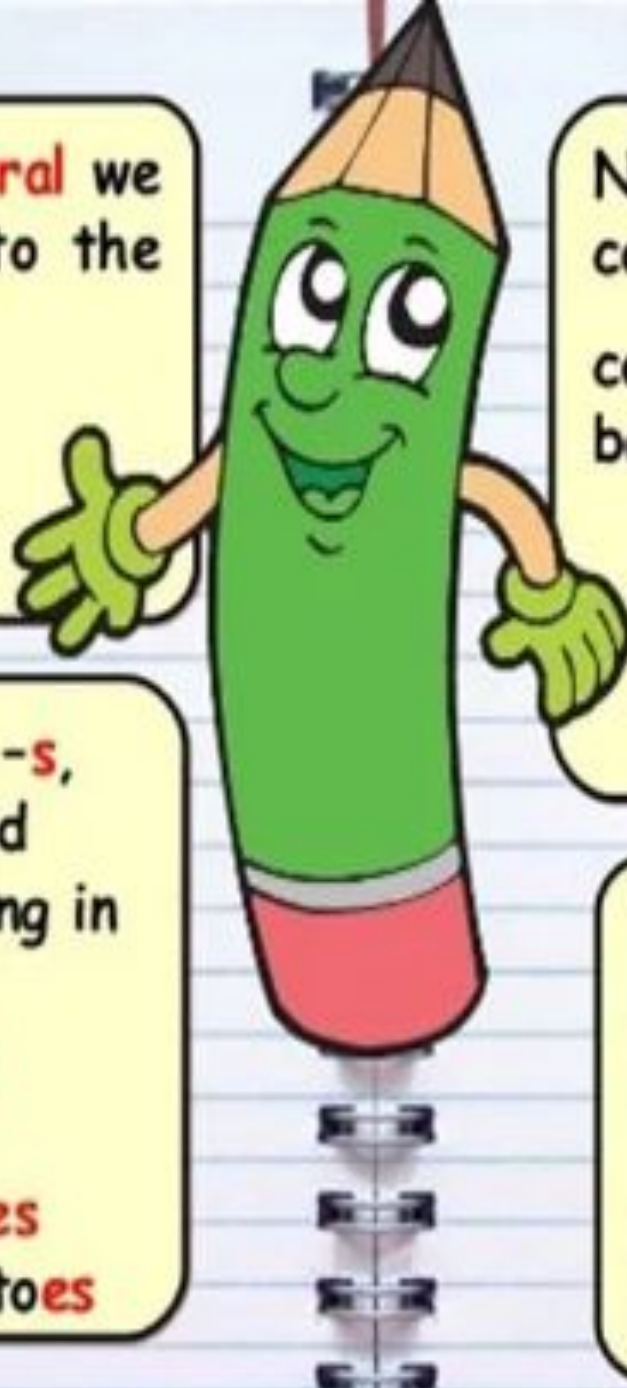
vowel + **y** → **s**
