1 **Nicolae** from Romania works in a pub in Manchester

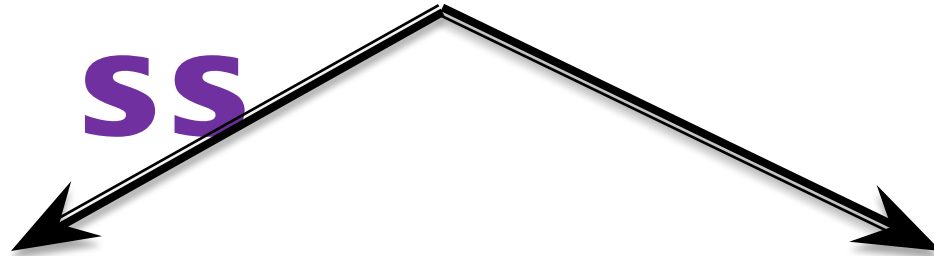
