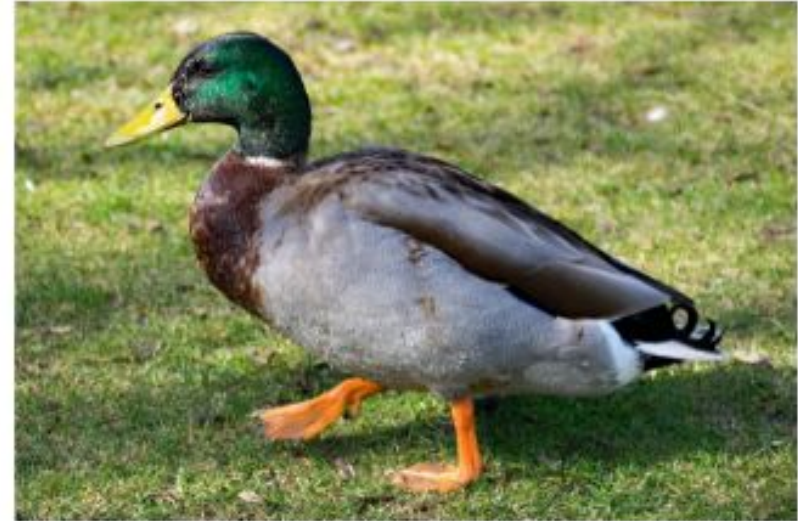

# Degrees of Comparison of Adjectives

## I способ

... **-er** **-est**

1. **Односложные** прилагательные.

➤ New – new**er** – the new**est**

2. **Двусложные** прилагательные с ударением на **втором** слого.

➤ Polite – polit**er** – the polit**est**

3. **Двусложные** прилагательные, оканчивающиеся на:  
**-er; -ow; -y; -le.**

➤ Easy – eas**ier** – the eas**iest**

## II способ

... – **more...** – **most...**  
**less...** **least ...**

Все остальные прилагательные

➤ Interesting – **more** interesting – the **most** interesting;

➤ Tired – **more** tired – the **most** tired

## Исключения

✓ Good – better – the best


✓ Bad – worse – the worst

✓ Little – less – the least

✓ Many (much) – more – the most

✓ Old – older – the oldest

elder – the eldest

far (далекий)	farther – <i>дальний (по расстоянию)</i> further - <i>дальний (по порядку)</i>	the farthest – <i>самый дальний (по расстоянию)</i> the furthest - <i>самый дальний (по порядку)</i>
near (близкий)	nearer - <i>ближний</i>	the nearest - <i>самый близкий по расстоянию</i> the next - <i>следующий по порядку</i>
late (поздний)	later - <i>позже (по времени)</i> latter - <i>последний (по счету)</i>	the latest - <i>последний</i> the last <i>самый поздний</i>

- **Twice as... as** - в два раза...чем
- **As...as possible** - как можно...
- **The...the...** - чем...тем...
- **Much...than** - гораздо...чем
- **A bit...than** - немного...чем
