#### Have you got any pets? -




I haven't got any pets, but I would love to have a dog. My favorite type of pet is an English bulldog. I think they are so nice and loving and I really want one.

Yes, I really love animals.






# Is nature something that interests you? –

# What are your plans for next weekend? –




Are you going away soon? Where?

Do you usually visit places of interest or go to the beach?


-Yes, I try to visit as many places that I can.
