Speak, talk, tell, say

Say - express something with words.

•Tell - means to give information to a person.

Speak = Talk – exchange information with somebody.

* speak languges

Examples

- "Where are they going? She didn't say."
- "Where are they going? She didn't **tell me**." (She didn't give me the information)
- "What did he say?"
- "What did he **tell you**?" (what information did he give you?)
- "Say 'hi' to Paul for me!"
- "Tell Paul I said hi!"
- "I want to say something about our teacher."
- "I want to **tell you** something about our teacher."

- "I spoke with my manager yesterday."
- "I talked with my manager yesterday."
- "I speak three languages."
