

Speak, talk, tell, say

- Say - express something with words.
- Tell - means to give information to a ***person***.
- Speak = Talk – exchange information with somebody.

* speak languages

Examples

- “Where are they going? She didn’t **say**.”
- “Where are they going? She didn’t **tell me**.” (She didn’t give me the information)
- “What did he **say**?”
- “What did he **tell you**?” (what information did he give you?)
- “**Say** ‘hi’ to Paul for me!”
- “**Tell Paul** I said hi!”
- “I want to **say** something about our teacher.”
- “I want to **tell you** something about our teacher.”

- *“I spoke with my manager yesterday.”*
- *“I talked with my manager yesterday.”*
- *“I speak three languages.”*
