

Speak, talk, tell, say

- Say - express something with words.
- Tell - means to give information to a ***person***.
- Speak = Talk – exchange information with somebody.

* speak languages

Examples

- *“Where are they going? She didn’t **say**.”*
- *“Where are they going? She didn’t **tell me**.” (She didn’t give me the information)*
- *“What did he **say**?”*
- *“What did he **tell you**?” (what information did he give you?)*
- *“**Say** ‘hi’ to Paul for me!”*
- *“**Tell Paul** I said hi!”*
- *“I want to **say** something about our teacher.”*
- *“I want to **tell you** something about our teacher.”*

- *“I spoke with my manager yesterday.”*
- *“I talked with my manager yesterday.”*
- *“I speak three languages.”*
