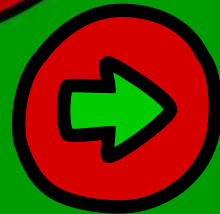

sound.



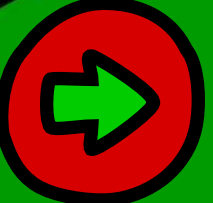
