I have one head.



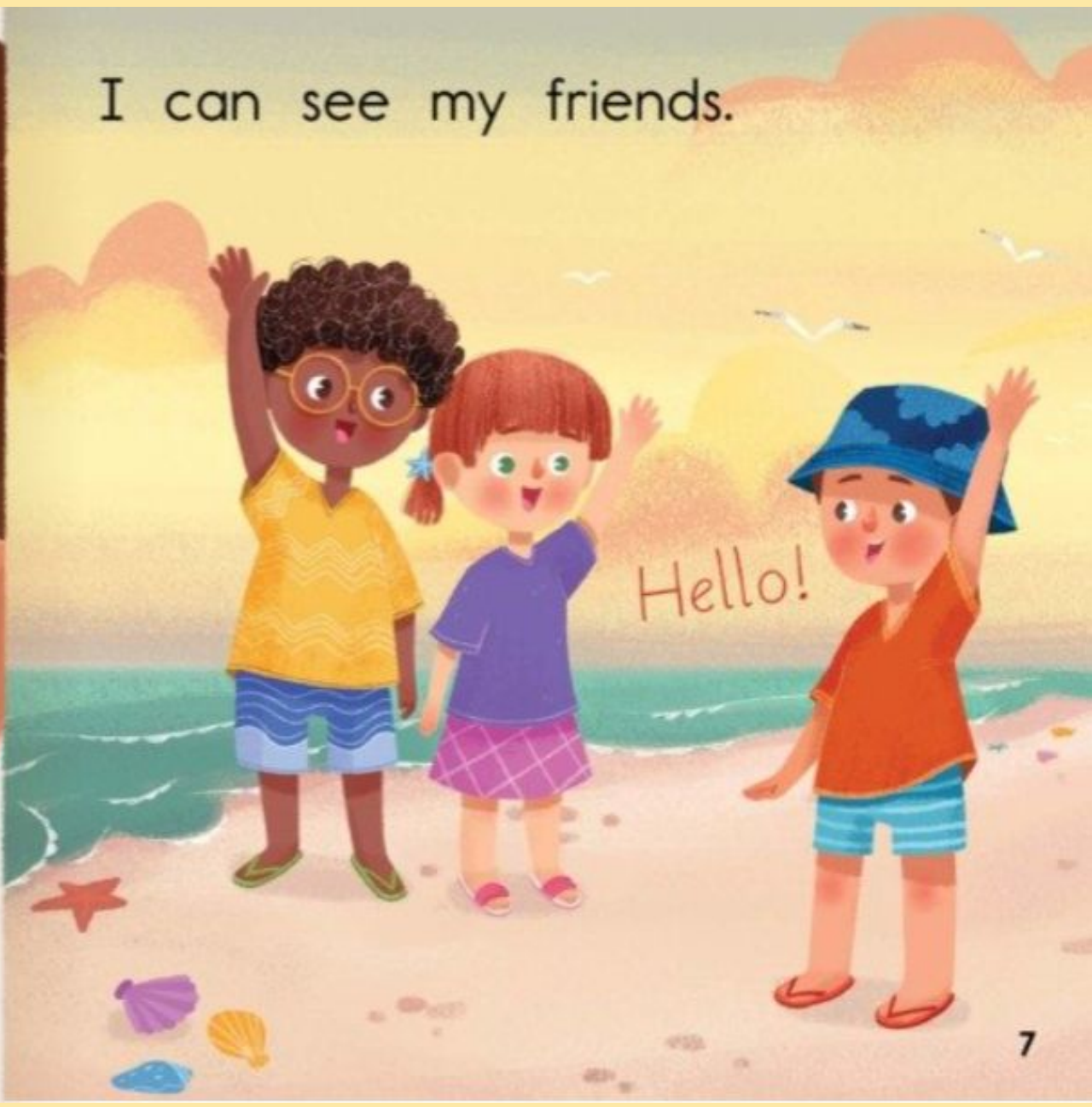
I can wear a hat.

Chirp!

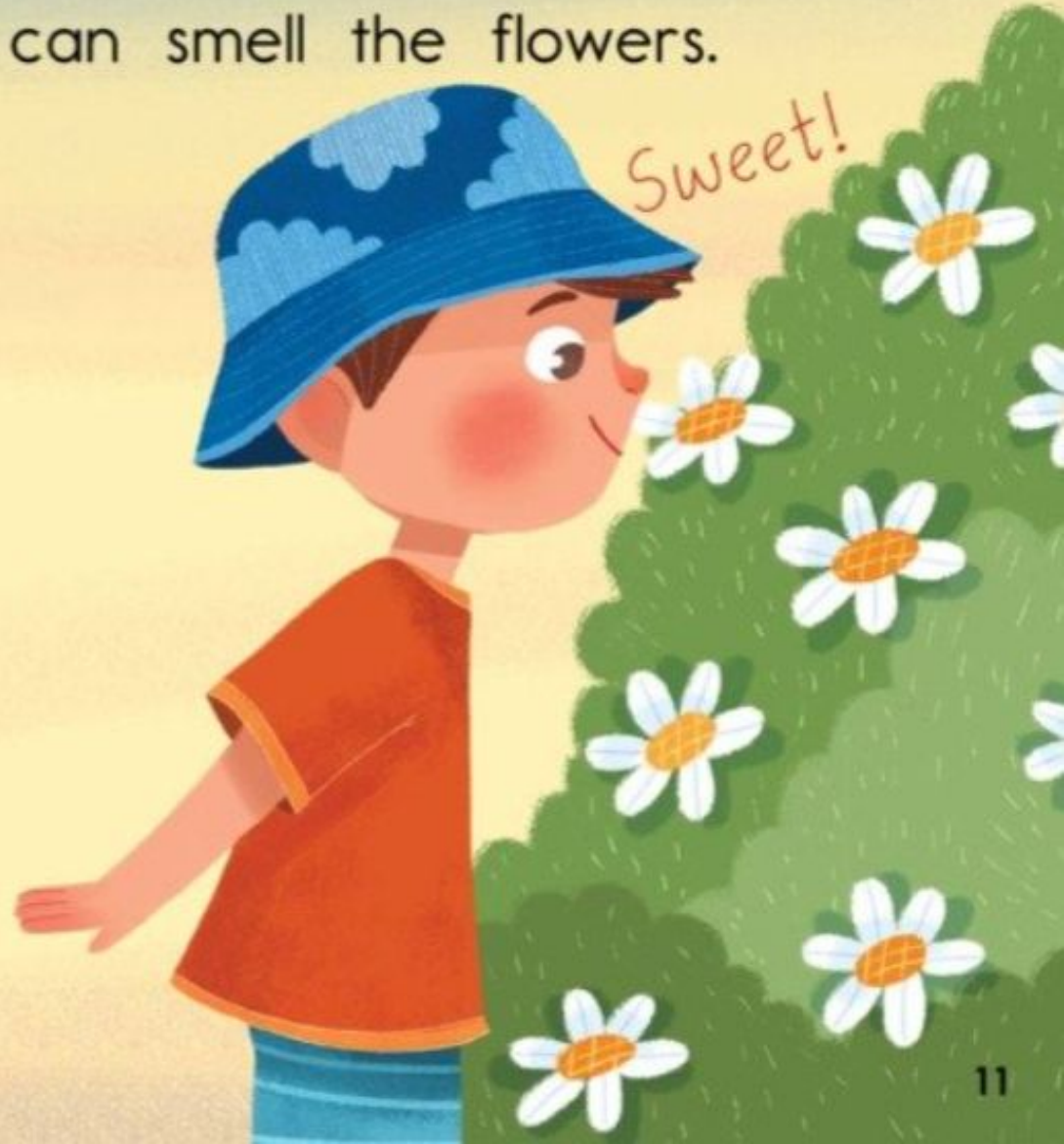
Chirp!

I have one mouth.



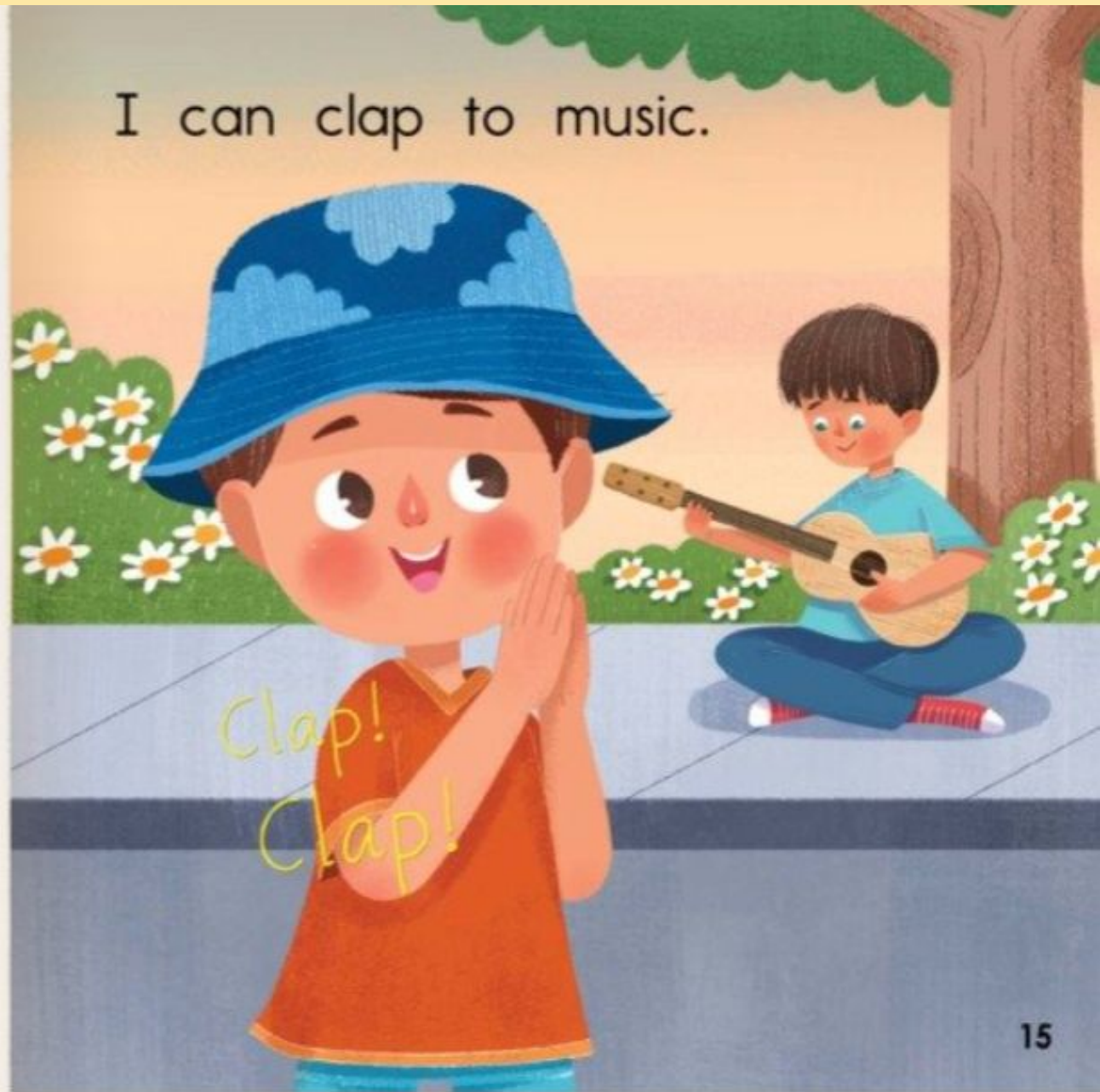
I can taste the ice-cream.

I can clap to music.





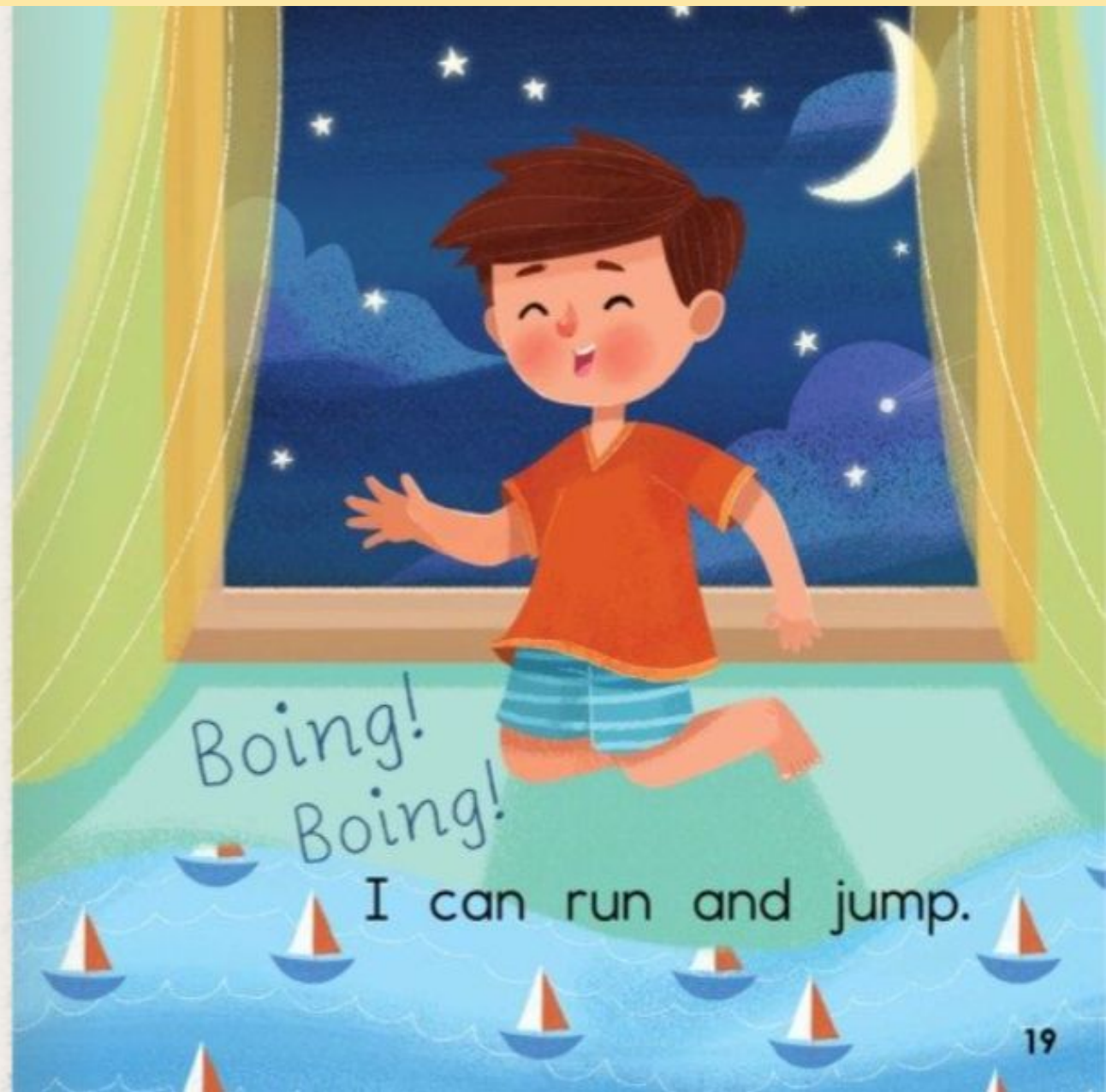
I have ten fingers.
