

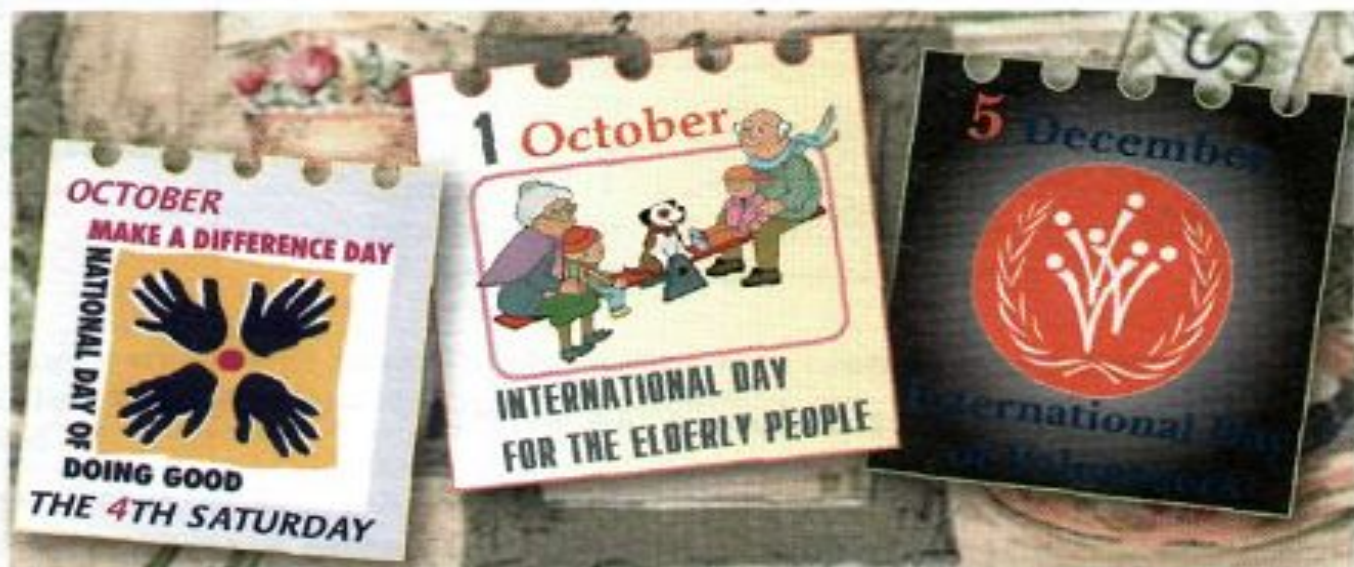

THE GERUND

Герундий

Герундий – это неличная форма глагола с окончанием **-ing**, которая обладает свойствами и глагола и существительного.

Подобной формы в русском языке нет

Перевод герундия на русский язык:

Поскольку формы герундия в русском языке нет, его значение может передаваться существительным, инфинитивом, деепричастием, глаголом в личной форме и придаточным предложением.

Ближе всего к герундию по смыслу в русском языке отглагольные существительные с суффиксами **-(е) ние, -тие, -ка, -ство** и др., а также глаголы в неопределенной форме.

Образование герундия

К инфинитиву без частицы to прибавляется окончание **–ing** (это так называемая IV форма глагола).

provide– providing

support– supporting

The Ving forms

Формы глагола с окончанием **-ing**

1. Форма **Ving** является неличной формой глагола, которая называет действие и сочетает в себе глагольные свойства со свойствами других частей речи и переводится на русский язык по-разному.

I'm good at **swimming**. — Я хорошо плаваю.

When I'm on holiday, I like **swimming**. — На каникулах я люблю плавать.

Swimming is my hobby. — Плавание — моё хобби.

We help children by **raising** money. — Мы помогаем детям, собирая деньги.

- be interested **in** – *интересоваться чем-либо*

- be good at – *быть способным к чему-то*

- ❖ We look forward **to making** donation to charities
