- 1) popular (loved / hated) / widespread / typical / common / rare / unique

- 4) physical, manual / mental, intellectual
 - simple / (physically, intellectually) demanding, hard, difficult, takes a lot of effort
 - reproductive (to copy) / artistic, creative (to make sth. new)
 - original, extraordinary, delicate / unoriginal, primitive, plain
 - professional / amateur
 - dangerous, risky / safe
 - real / imaginary, fake, a toy, is really doing sth / pretends that ...
- 5) requirements (education / qualifications / skills / knowledge / experience)

- 6) modern, up-to-date, state-of the-art, innovative, popular / traditional, outdated, old-fashioned, conservative, obsolete, a thing of the past
