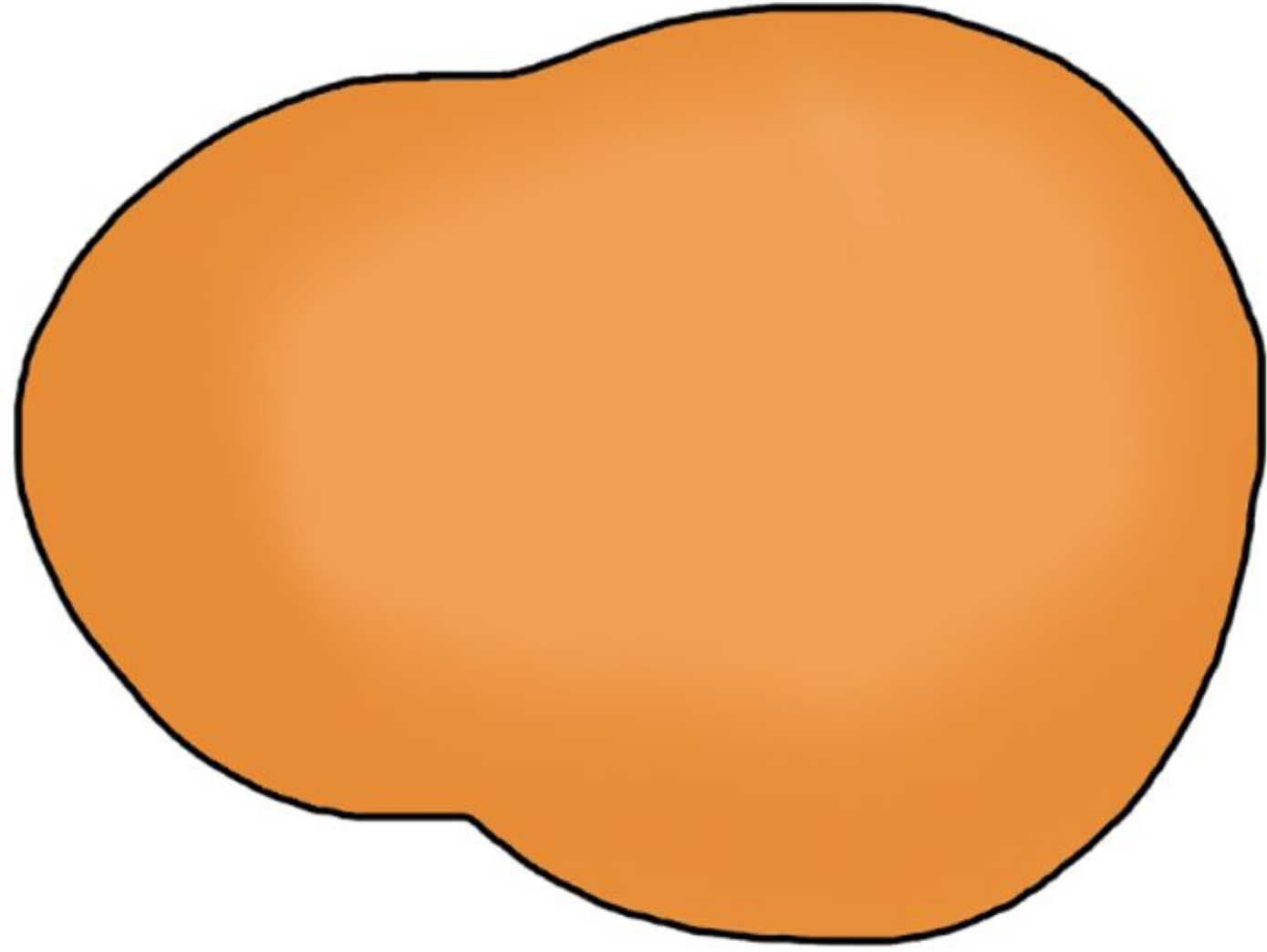
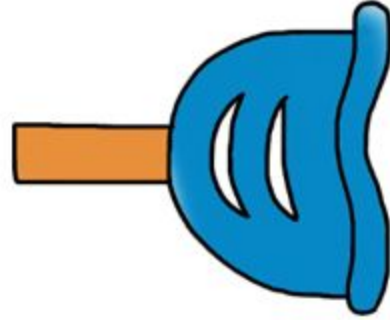
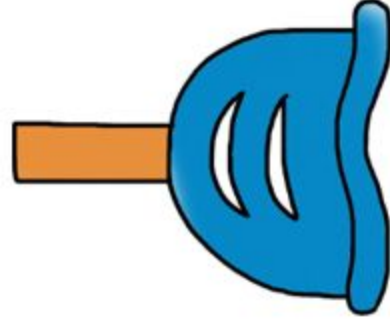
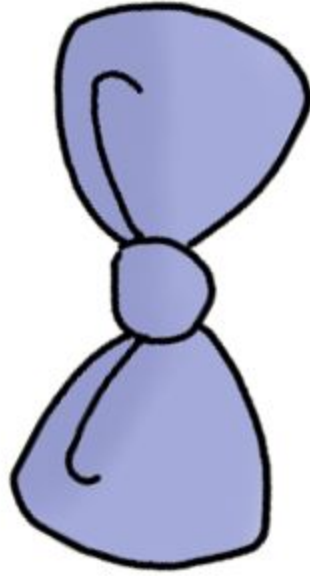
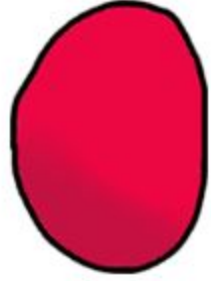
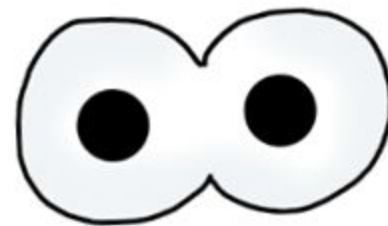
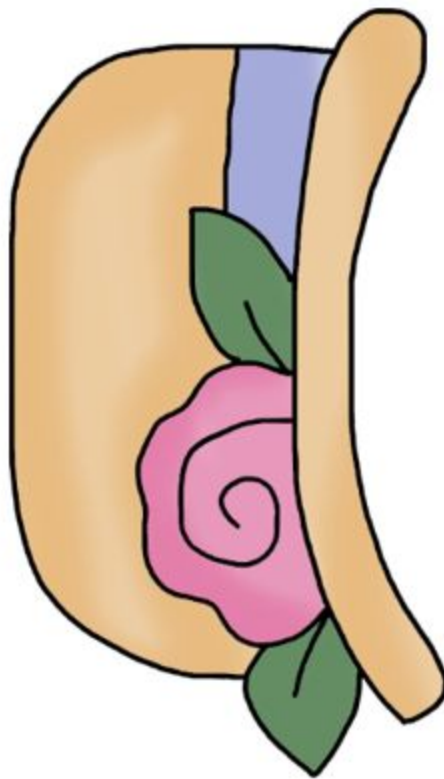
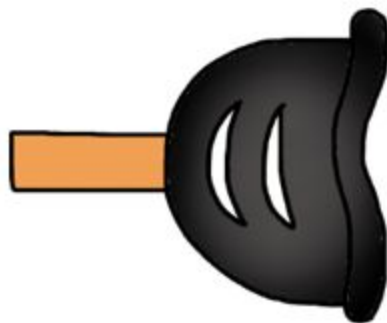
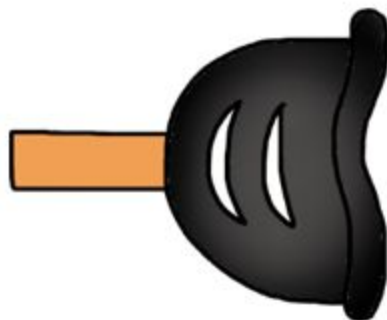


Potato Head

This is an example of how I constructed this book. It is bound on two sides so that one side contains the essential pieces and one has extras (hat, bow, mustache) that way you can fold one side behind the head so that the child does not see the extra pieces if they are not at that level. You may also further limit the essential pieces by placing extra mouths, nose, and feet on the back. I affixed these to the book with double sided tape but you could use Velcro. I thought this was a “cleaner” look but some kids may need the Velcro to aid in the motor part of them actually lifting the picture off the page. I hope you enjoy teaching body parts with this and even pairing with the actual potato head to start would be a good idea to bridge to the printed version.
