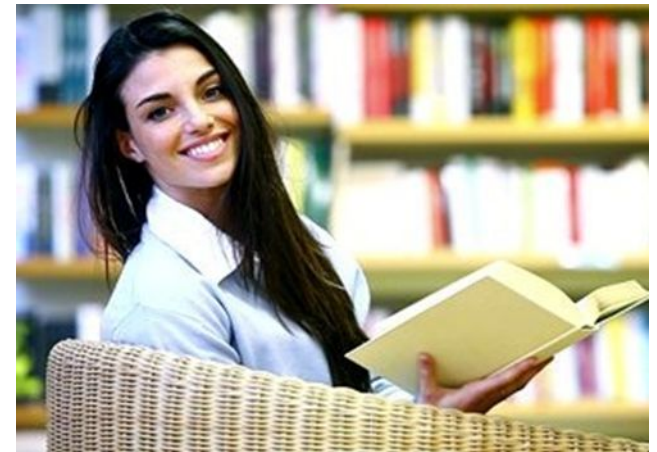

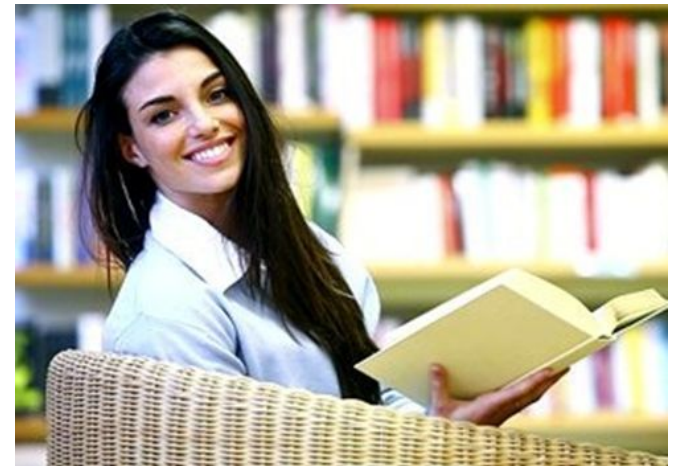


The girl is in her middle twenties. She has big brown eyes and long dark hair. She is wearing a light blue shirt. I think she is very beautiful.
