## *Complex Object*

1. I know that **he** is a good expert.

I know **him** to be a good expert.

2. We believe that **they** launched a new project.

We believe **them** to have launched a new project.

3. They expect that **we** will help them.

They expect **us** to help them.

## *Complex Object*

### **The verbs used with Complex Object**

- wish & intention:

to wish, to want, to desire, would like,  
to mean, to intend, to choose

- mental activity (generally with the verb “to be”)

to know, to expect, to believe, to think,  
to consider, to suppose, to expect,  
to imagine, to find, to feel, to trust

# Complex Object

- perception:

to see

to watch

to notice

to hear

to feel

to V

*e.g.* I heard **her** do the job well.

We saw **them** set the equipment.

to make

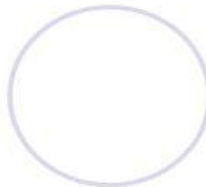
to let

to V

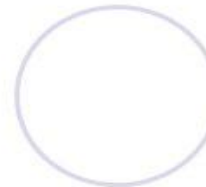
*e.g.* Let **me** introduce you our experts.

They made **him** send the project once more.

## *Complex Object*



**Compare**



Complex Object + Infinitive	Complex Object + Participle I
I saw him <b>enter</b> the room. I noticed him <b>frown</b> . I felt her <b>tremble</b> . I heard her <b>speak</b> .	I saw him <b>entering</b> the bar. I noticed him <b>frowning</b> . I felt her <b>trembling</b> . I heard her <b>speaking</b> .

# **Complex Object**

He wants **the book to be returned** tomorrow.

Он хочет, *чтобы книгу вернули* завтра.

Примеры **Complex Object**:

1. We expect **him to solve** this problem.
2. I don't consider **him to be** a good manager.
3. I know **her to have graduated** from the university three years ago.
4. The manager considers **the results to be** unsatisfactory.
5. I want **him to leave**.
6. We expect **John to be elected**.
7. We want **them to introduce** the changes as soon as possible.
8. We expect **interest rates to rise** next week.
9. The scientists expect **this effect to be** relatively small.
