

The Third Conditional

I wouldn't have woken up late if I hadn't stayed up late.



I woke up late because I stayed up late.

If he had been more careful, he wouldn't have had an accident.



He had an accident because he wasn't careful.

If Bob had studied harder, he wouldn't have failed the test.



Bob didn't pass the test because he didn't study hard.

Sarah wouldn't have needed fillings if he had brushed her teeth more frequently.



Sarah needed dental fillings because she didn't brush her teeth frequently.

Peter wouldn't have learnt Spanish, if he hadn't taken lessons.



Peter speaks Spanish because he took lessons.

If Brianna hadn't saved money, she couldn't have bought a fancy car.



Brianna bought a fancy car because she saved money.

**If it had rained, Mark and his son
wouldn't have gone fishing.**



Mark and his son went fishing because it didn't rain.

Ron wouldn't have arrested if he hadn't been caught shoplifting.



Ron was arrested because he was caught shoplifting.

Fred wouldn't have put on weight if he hadn't eaten too much.



Fred put on weight because he ate too much.



If Tara hadn't argued with all her friends, she wouldn't be alone on her birthday.



Tara is alone on her birthday because she argued with all her friends.
