

# Prepositions in Time Expressions

What time are we leaving?

We are leaving in 20 minutes. We have to be there at 5 o'clock.



**Prepositions** show time, place, movement, and other relationships between words.

Prepositions of time include **at**, **in**, **on**.

What time are we leaving?

We are leaving **in** 20 minutes. We have to be there **at** 5 o'clock.





We need to be there **at**  
5:00, so we should  
leave **in** 10 minutes.  
We want to be **on** time.

**Prepositions** show time.

Prepositions of time include **at, in, on.**

## Prepositions of time

<b>at</b>	a specific time night	<b>at</b> 8:30 <b>at</b> night
-----------	--------------------------	-----------------------------------

Amy goes to school **at** 8:30.

We have choir practice **at** night.

## Prepositions of time

<b>in</b>	a specific month	<b>in</b> February
	a specific year	<b>in</b> 1981
	the morning	<b>in</b> the morning
	the afternoon	<b>in</b> the afternoon
	the evening	<b>in</b> the evening

Valentine's Day is **in** February.

I earned my PhD **in** 1981.

We eat breakfast **in** the morning.

They got married **in** the afternoon.

The moon is out **in** the evening.

## Prepositions of time

<b>on</b>	a specific day of the week a specific date	<b>on</b> Monday <b>on</b> Dec. 30 <sup>th</sup>
-----------	---	---

She has piano lessons **on** Monday.  
Zoe's birthday is **on** December 30<sup>th</sup>.

We studied English **last night**.

I saw a great movie **two weeks ago**.
