the logo of the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio de Janeiro was immediately accused of plagiarism . The journalists found significant similarities with the logo of the American charitable foundation Telluride Foundation. Both logos feature stylized figures of people dancing hand-in-hand.





The logo depicts an Inukshuk statue named Ilanaak, which means “friend” in the Inuktitut language. The image was taken from a statue standing on the shore of English Bay in Vancouver. Green, blue, and cyan represent forests, mountains, and the ocean, red represents the color of the maple leaf on the flag of Canada, and yellow represents the color of the rising sun.
