

questions

- we use **the same word order** in the question as in the **statement**
auxiliary

Who told you the news?

(Stuart told you the news.)

(Our team won the match.)

Which team won the match?

- we use an **auxiliary**
(e.g. do, does, did, be, have or modal verb)

Can I borrow your pen?

Do you have much homework?

- we can use **questions words**

What are you waiting for?

How many people have you invited to the party?

- in questions with prepositions,
the preposition goes at the end of the sentence

*Who did you go to the cinema **with**?*

*What is he talking **about**?*
