(Stuart told you the news.)

(Our team won the match.)
Which team won the match?

we use an auxiliary
 (e.g. do, does, did, be, have or modal verb)

Can I borrow your pen?

Do you have much homework?

we can use questions words

What are you waiting for?

How many people have you invited to the party?

in questions with prepositions,
 the preposition goes at the end of
 the sentence

Who did you go to the cinema with?

What is he talking about?
