Adjectives	Adverbs
simple gentle	simply gently
angry merry	angrily merrily
careful beautiful	carefully beautifully



Adverbs are words that show *how*, *when*, *where*, *how much*, or *why* things happen. Most adverbs are words that end in *-ly*. Here are some *-ly* adverbs you may know: *certainly*, *fearfully*, *horribly*, *only*. But not all words that end in *-ly* are adverbs.

- We use **adverbs** to describe **HOW** somebody do something

*I read **quickly**. You can do it **easily**.*

- to create adverbs we normally add “**-ly**” to an adjective.

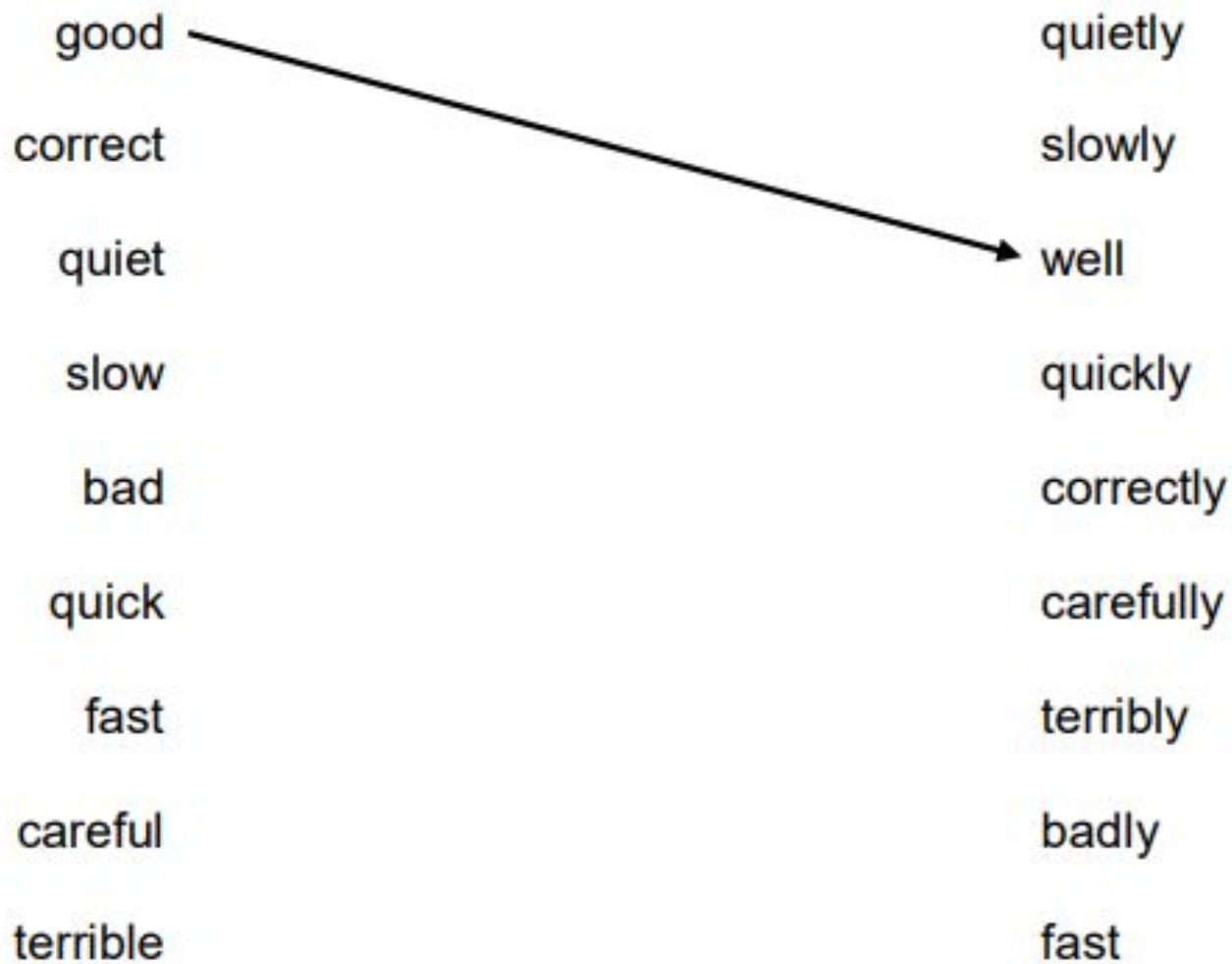
