Adverbs are words that show how, when, where, how much, or why things happen. Most adverbs are words that end in -ly. Here are some *-ly* adverbs you may know: certainly, fearfully, horribly, only. But not all words that end in -ly are adverbs.

We use adverbs to describe HOW somebody do something

to create adverbs we normally add "-ly" to an adjective.


