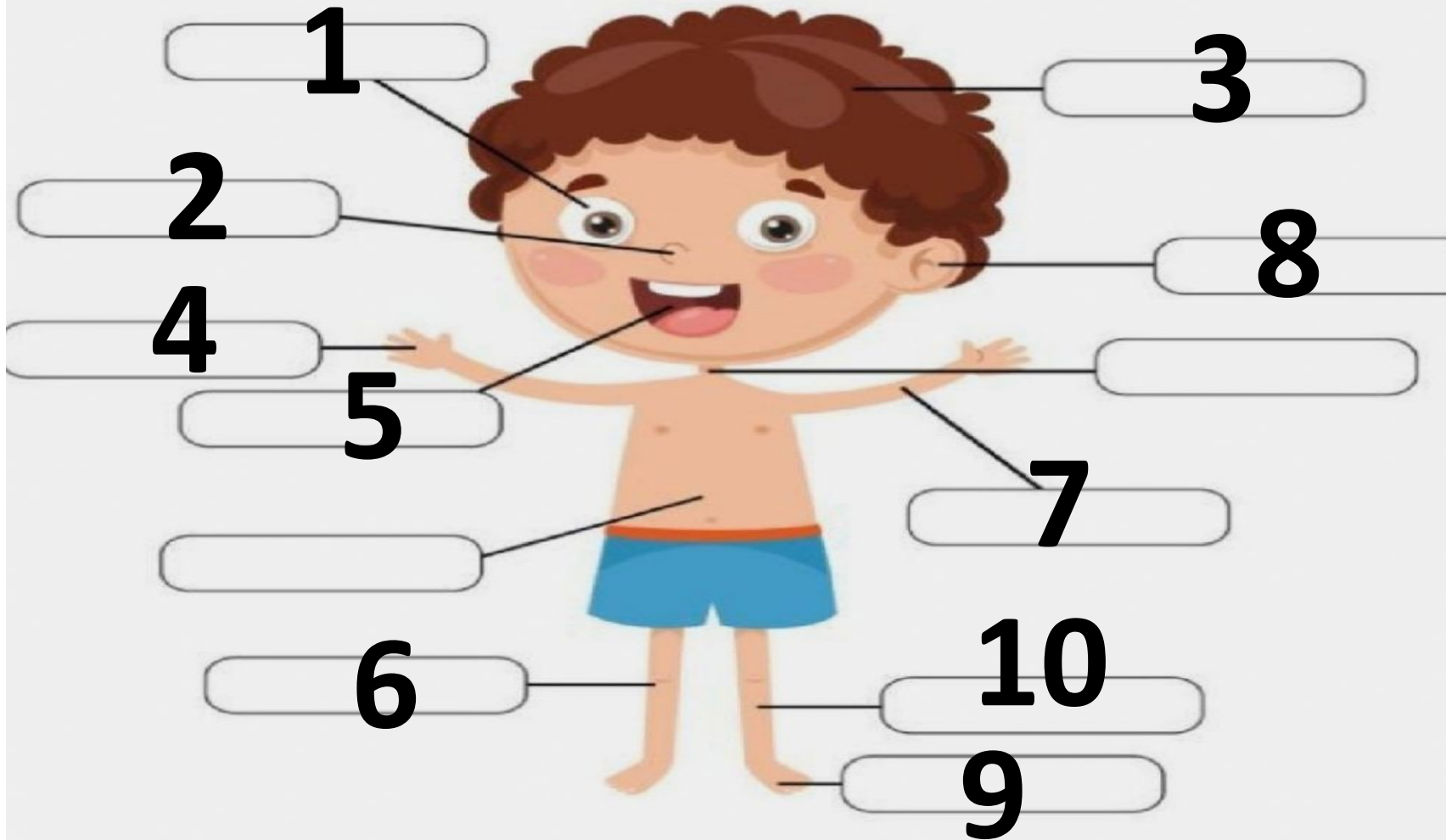






noun	singular	+/-	plural
most nouns	cat	+ s	cats
ending in -s, -sh, -ch, -x	bush	+ es	bushes
ending in -y	baby	> ies	babies
ending in -ay, -oy, -ey	day	+ s	days
ending in -f, -fe	knife	> ves	knives
some nouns ending in -o	potato	+ es	potatoes
