- 3. The second thesis
- 4. Evidence for the first thesis
- 5. Arguments for the second thesis
- 6. Conclusion

 - First, I want to say that...
 - Another thing is...

C. Make a conclusion.

Closing phrase: <u>I have come to the end of my talk. / That's all I wanted to say. Thank you for listening.</u>
