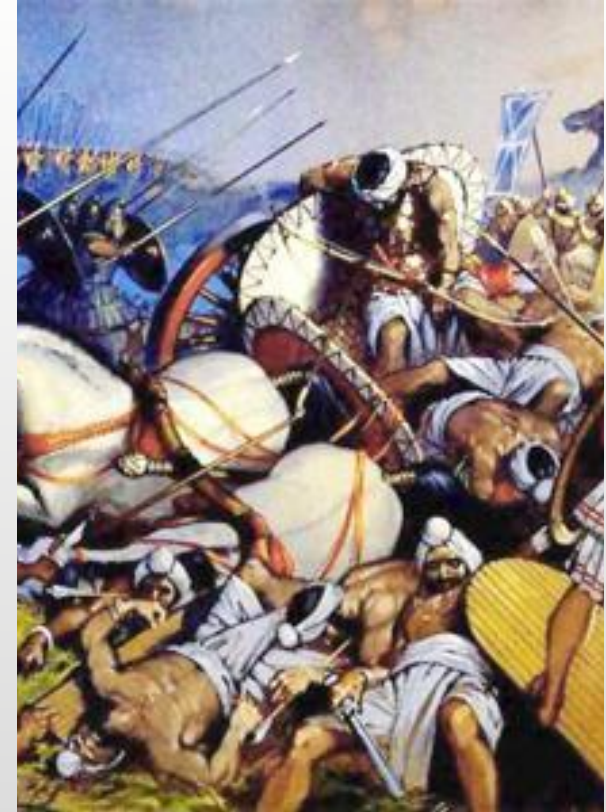

- I. Kalinga War :

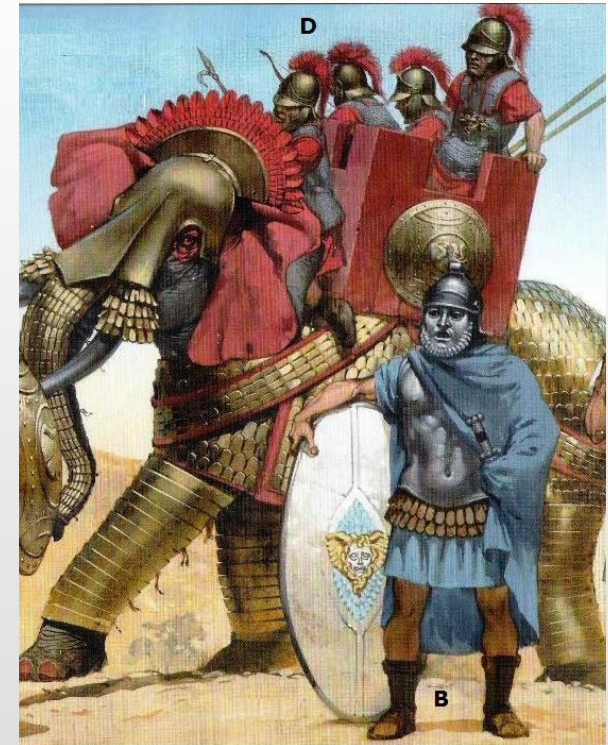
- Year : 262-261 BCE
- India and allies : Mauryan Empire
- Opponents : Kalinga
- Outcome : ~ Maurya Victory
~ Maurya annexation of Kalinga



2. SELEUCID MAURAYAN WAR :

- Year : 305-303 BC
- India and allies : Maurya
- Opponents : Seleucid
- Outcome : ~ for Eastern satrapies of Macedonian empire annexed by Maurya .

~ Chandragupta married Seleucus's daughter in exchange for 500 war elephants.

 - Opponents : Western Chalukya Empire
 - Outcome : Chola Victory

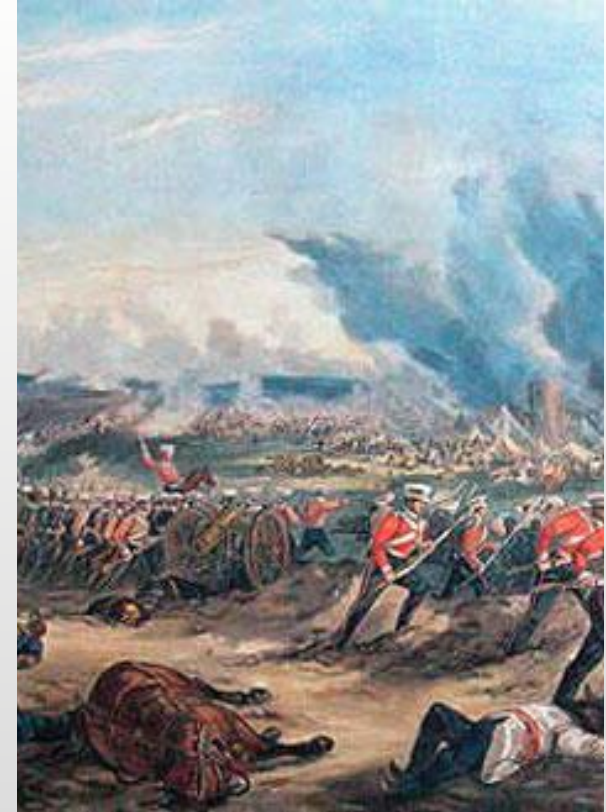
2. MUGHAL SALAVID WAR

- Year : 1622-1623
- India and allies : Mughal Empire
- Opponents : Safavid Empire
- Outcome : ~ Persian Victory
~ Safavid/Persian Annexation of kandhar.



3. DECCAN WAR :

- Year : 1681-1707
- India and allies : Mughal Empire
- Opponents : Maratha Empire
- Outcome : ~ Maratha Victory
~ Permanent end to Mughal expansion in
Deccan/Peninsular India.

~ No territorial Changes

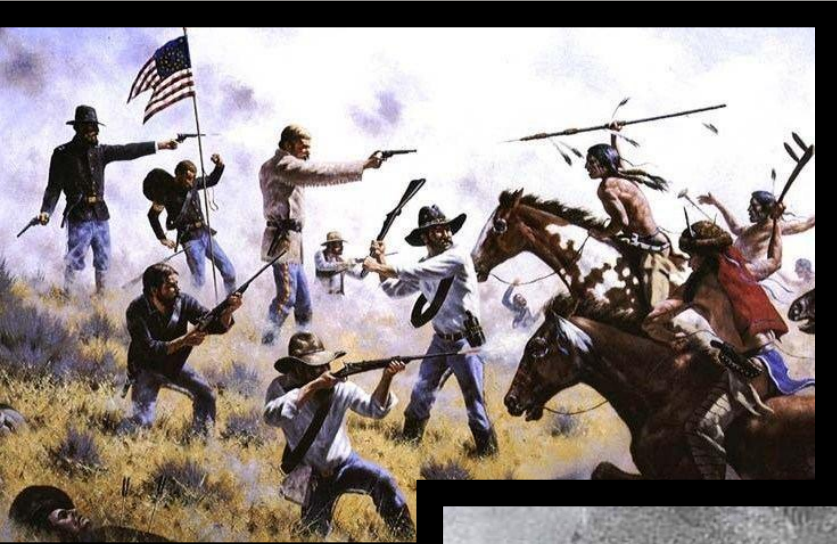


3. SIACHEN CONFLICT :
