- She was crowned on 2 June 1953.

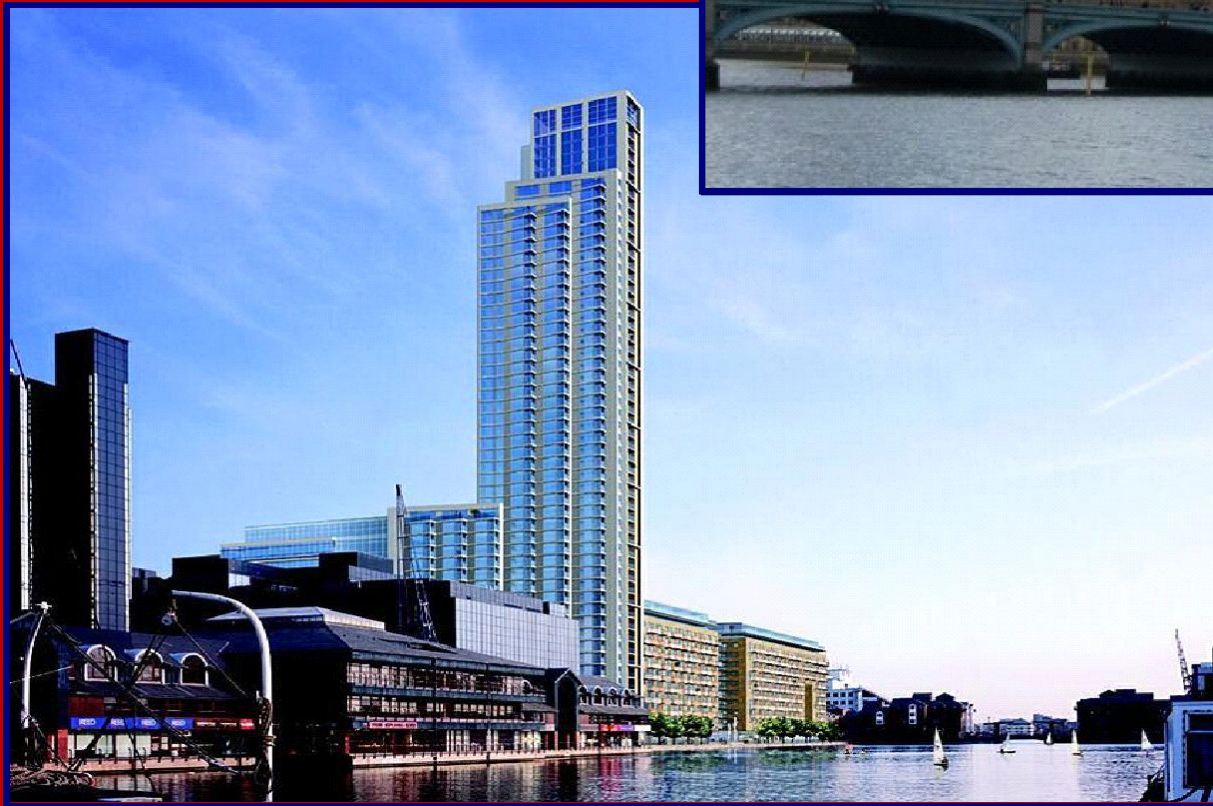


London
