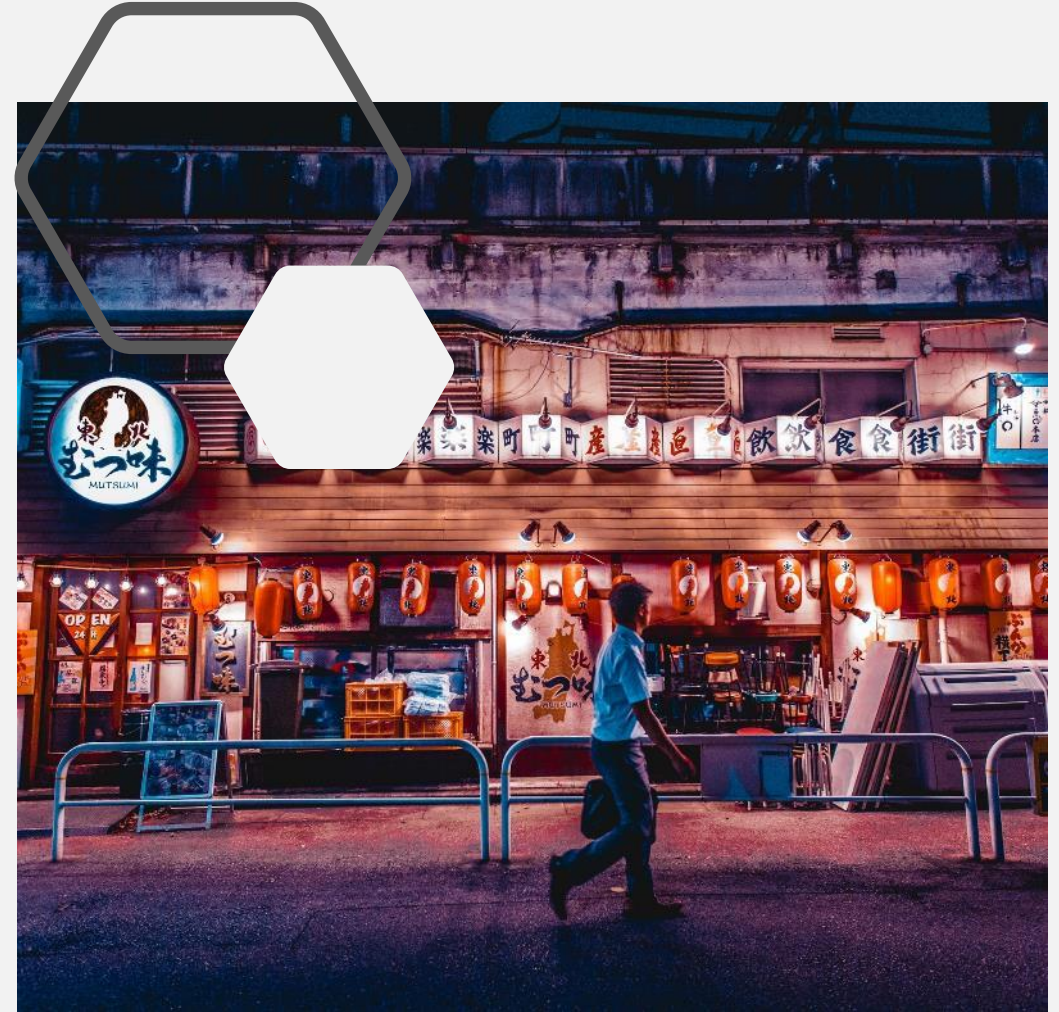

# introduction

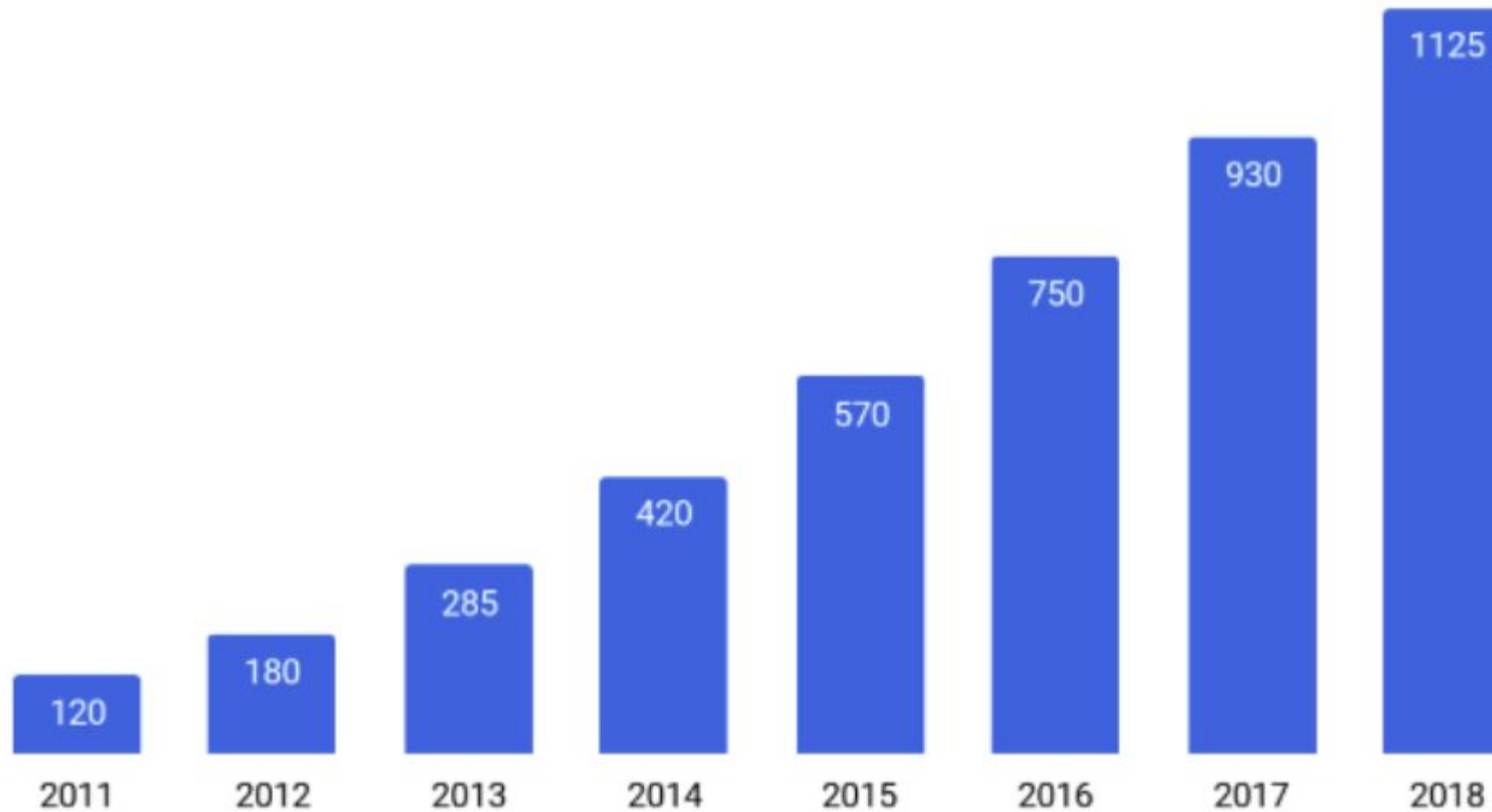


- China The largest state in the world by population (over 1.385 billion ).

The first - Because of the cheap cost of living

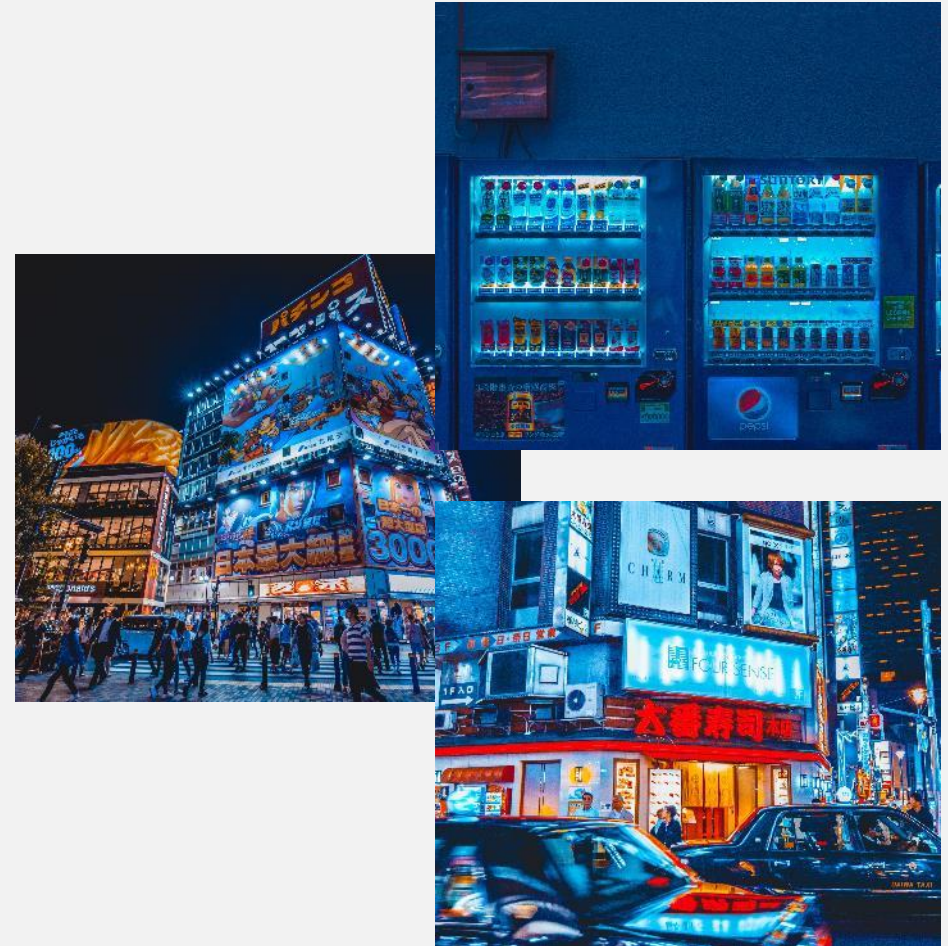
- Low cost of rent housing.

- The average salary of a programmer is 1600 \$
- The average salary of a engineers telecommunication technologies is 3000 \$
- The average salary of a construction engineer is 1750 \$

The third – for study Chinese universities are almost the most prestigious in the world.



# Cons

All three migrants face the same problems.

- The main minus is Ecology. Currently, the issue of ecology is very important, and it is considered in all countries of the world. However, in China, due to the number of factories, factories and other industrial enterprises, the environment is in a deplorable state. Exceptions are provinces that are far from megacities.
- Traffic on the roads. Chinese insanely noisy road, drivers honk all the time. There are practically no rules of the road. Drivers without warning can pass back, turn or move to another lane. It is almost impossible to cross the road at the crossing.
- The Internet. The Chinese Internet is a real test for the nervous system. He is very overloaded, works slowly and intermittently. Fast and high-quality internet is very expensive. Unlimited Internet is a rare occurrence

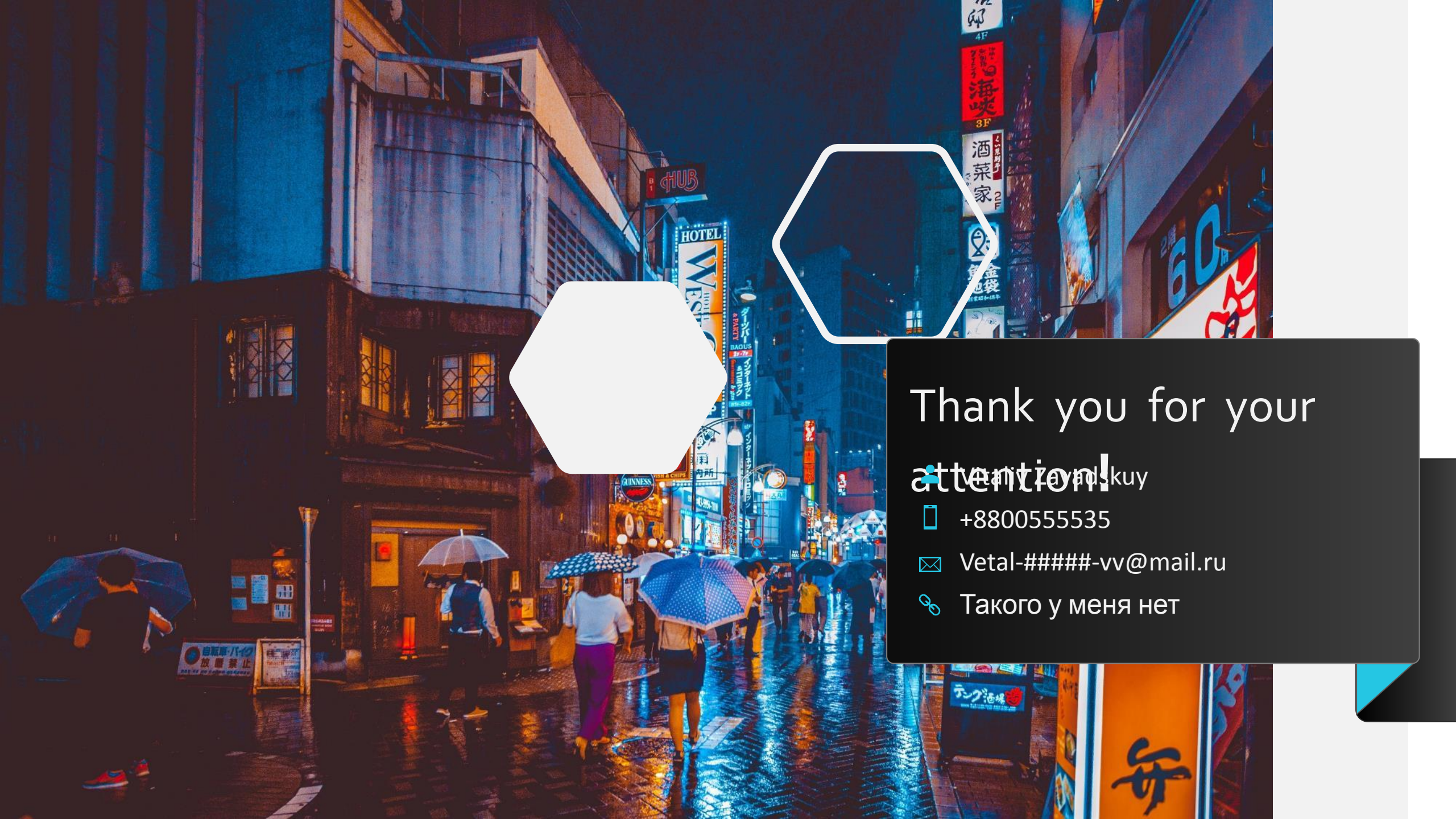
## Cons
