

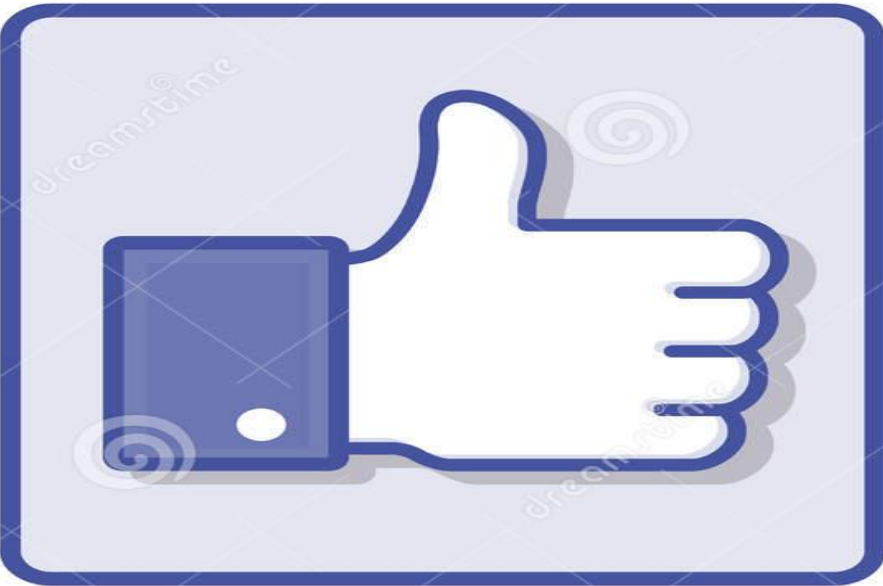

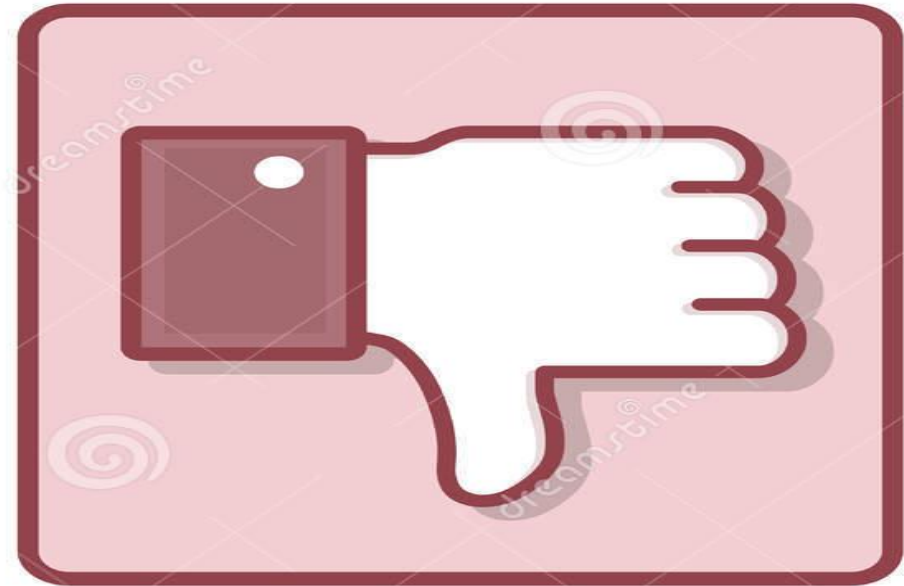

- *I don't have **many** friends.*
- *Do you think **many** people will go?*

**a lot of**

+

**any noun**

(любое существительное)

- *I need **a lot of** coffee.*  
(= *I need **lots of** coffee.*)
- *There is **a lot of** traffic today.*

- *She has **a lot of** friends.*  
(= *She has **lots of** friends.*)
- *There are **a lot of** cars on the street.*

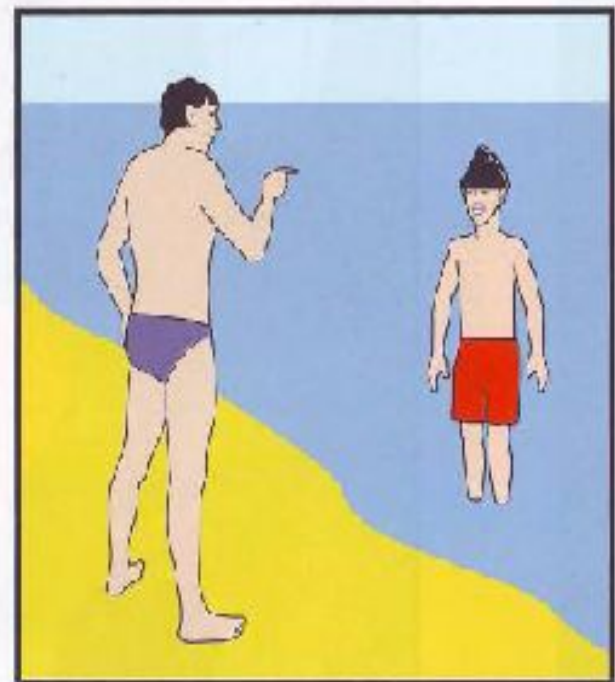
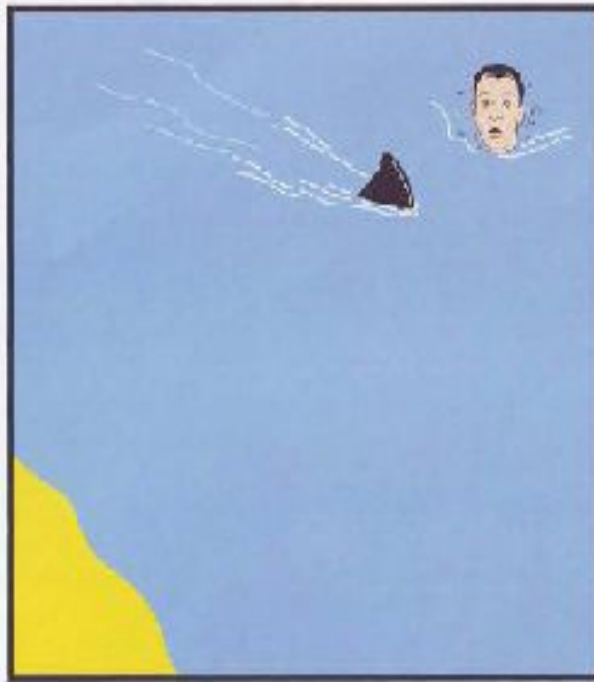
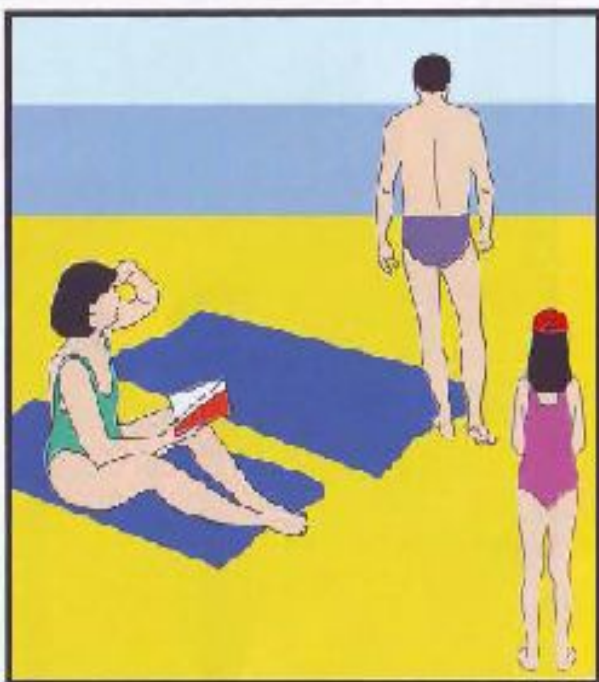


## Present Continuous.
