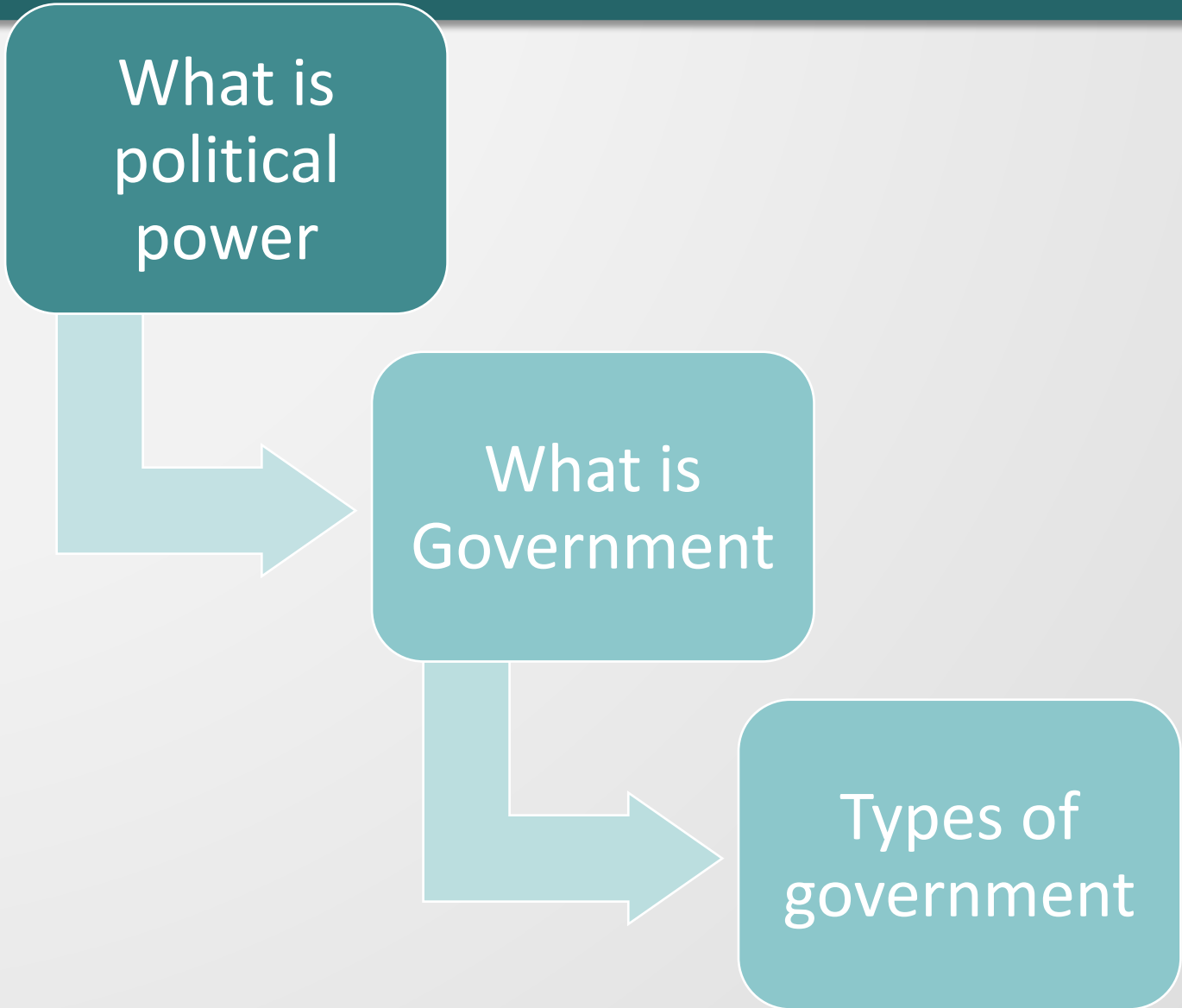

- the ability to exercise one's will over others



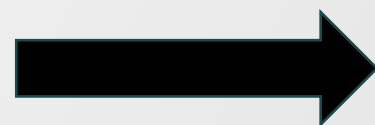

- Cooperation between individuals

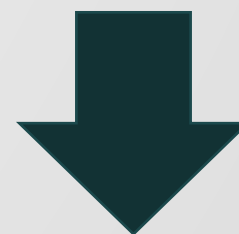


COOPERATION

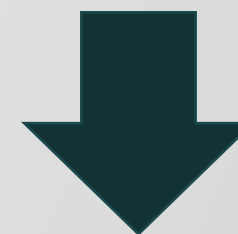
- Power to restrain individual behaviours

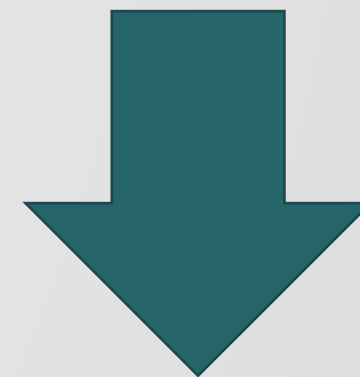
