WALES**

- Prince Harry of Wales, full name Henry (Harry) Charles Albert David Mountbatten-Windsor — the younger son of the prince of Wales Charles and his first wife princess Diana, the grandson of the queen of Great Britain Elizabeth II. Now the fifth in turn of successors of a throne of the United Kingdom



- Harry was born on September 15, 1984 at 16:20, in the Saint hospital of Mary in Paddington, the central region of London.
- At first Harry attended kindergarten
- In 1987 has gone to school of Uezerbi in London
- Since 1992 has joined prince William and became the pupil of school of Ladgrouv in Berkshire where has studied the next five





- On August 31, 1997, when he was 12 years old, his mother princess Diana has died in road accident in Paris.



- In 1998 he has come to the Eton college which had left in 2003 with a negative grade in geography.
- Being then on the academic vacation within a year, has gone to Australia
- Then has spent several months in Africa where has shot the documentary The Forgotten Kingdom: Prince Harry in Lesotho about a difficult life of orphans of the state of Lesotho. For activity in Lesotho personally it and the younger brother of the king of Lesotho Letsie III prince Seeiso Bereng Seeiso in April, 2006 have founded the charitable organization Sentebale — for the help to children and teenagers of the country.



- In 2005 has been admitted to Royal military academy where it appeared under a conditional surname of Wales; has successfully completed a 44 weeks course of trainings and in April, 2006 in a rank of the second lieutenant has been enlisted in the regiment Blues and Royals of the Palace cavalry.
- In May, 2007 it has been decided to send the prince to Afghanistan. In December, 2007 — February, 2008 served in the Province of Helmand as the aviation tipper-of.





- On April 16, 2011 to him the rank of the captain of the Army air case has been given.
- From September 7, 2012 to January, 2013 was in another official journey on the basis of Camp Bastion in the south of Afghanistan, was regularly involved in combat operations, risked the life for performance of a fighting task.



- As to the member of royal family, on the eighteen-anniversary he has been granted the personal coat of arms based on the coat of arms of the monarch of the United Kingdom.

- Knight commodore of the Royal Victorian award
- Medal of Gold anniversary of Queen Elizabeth II
- Medal "For Participation in a Military Campaign in Afghanistan"
- Medal of Diamond anniversary of Queen Elizabeth II
